**** Due to the inconvenience of time to schedule meetings and to have everyone participate this list of rules was made for you people who greet Sunday Patients. Please read and sign your name, so you will be held responsible if you break any of these rules.**

- 1) You are to be on time and stay in the privillion if the patients have arrived or not.
- 2) Stay in Area at all time.
- 3) Smile be friendly and relaxed when talking to guest.
- 4) Your conversation should be mild, speak of yourself or them. Ask where do they work? How old are they? How many children do they have? Do they know anything about Herbs? How did they find out about Jonestown? What have they heard about Jonestown? If they have been here before ask what did they think about the treatment. Or any ~~any~~ other question like these.
- 5) DO NOT talk about politics.
- 6) DO NOT TALK ABOUT SOCIALISM OR COMMUNISM...
- 7) If the person ask alot of political questions, excuse yourself and find someone in P.R. like Lee, Johnny, Sarah, Prokes, Shanda, Ava, etc. But don't be so obvious.
- 8) DO NOT take people on tours of the property. They are here to be seen by the Doctor.
- 9) No guest are to go to the Library, because of different literature in the library.
- 10) The guest are to use the guest toilets only***
- 11) You are responsible to see that no guest goes off by themselves. Make sure someone, yourself or your partners accompany them at all times.
- 12) If your relief does not show up, you are not to get up and leave the patients alone
- 13) If your partner is getting to political or out of hand . Call them to the side or find me /Rhonda.
- 14) REMEMBER.. we are not responsible to give these people transportation. Never say we will get you a ride. Say if there is a tractor going out then you can have a ride.
- 15) DO NOT OFFER OR PROMISE ANY RIDE.
- 16) If its getting late then find me so I can tell them to go home, or try to let the Dr. know what time it is.
