Since 1950, Perfect Circle employees have received wage increases totalling over 77 cents per hour. The 5 cent wage increase of March 1, 1958 made this the highest in the piston ring industry. Increases in most other companies have totalled about 25 cents below that amount. We have willingly increased our wage rates faster than the industry when it was safe to do so.

All of this information has been discussed during negotiations. From this information these conclusions must be reached:

1. Business conditions are significantly less favorable than they were a year ago.
2. Competition for the existing piston ring business has definitely favored those companies with lower wage costs.
3. We cannot expect to pass any increased costs on to our customers in the form of higher prices. Many of our customers are insisting on lower prices.
4. The prospects of our regaining normal work schedules and employment will be hurt if we do anything to further increase the difference between our wage and those of our competitors who are gaining business.

Serena Hunt: Serena is the senior citizen Lois Ponts brought up from Fresno without clearance in 1976, who was eventually placed in a resthome on Medi-Cal with help of a Dr. Alan Lewis, by Rheavina & Jack. We have received mail addressed to Rheavina that the resthome Serena is in will no longer be eligible for Medi-Cal patients April 1, 1978, and that Serena be relocated to another Medi-Cal approved facility of her choice as soon as possible.

The background on this case is known by Chaikin: There had been a problem with placing her in a resthome under Medi-Cal because she had property in Fresno and 2 savings accounts. She signed a deed granting ownership in property over to P.T. as a gift, and this was recorded 7/9/76, making it public record that property belonged to P.T. She signed release of savings accounts and they were closed and donated to P.T. She signed power of attorney and appointed Jack & Rheavina as attorneys in fact to act on her behalf. We sold the house, proceeds \$23,000, in 9/76. After Rheavina went overseas, Hue Fortson & Kris Kice have made regular visits as official members of P.T. to make it clear that P.T. had not just placed this old woman in a rest home and ignored her.

Stoen and Cartmell were in on this case from the beginning.

- A. Do we now have any obligation to this woman as far as placement?
- B. Could we write or call Dr. Lewis and explain that Rheavina and Jack are both overseas and we would appreciate him doing same that he did last time, find a rest home that will take Medi-Cal patients?
- C. Or could we write directly to the Dept. of Health, who was the agency that wrote to Serena notifying her that she will have to be relocated, and explain the same?

Dear Friends and Relatives of the Residents of the
San Franciscan Center:

As you are no doubt aware, the California State Department of Health is preparing to relocate the residents of the Center. The residents, along with attorneys from Public Advocates, the Gray Panther organization and other community groups have fought hard to keep the San Franciscan Center open and to force the State to live up to its obligations to the elderly.

The pressures of time, money and an unyielding and uncaring State bureaucracy have made this struggle more difficult than any of us imagined. While we have not given up the fight and will continue to search for a way to save the Center, relocation is now a very real possibility. In fact, it appears to be a certainty.

Although we are not abandoning our attempts to find an operator for the Center, necessity has forced us to concentrate on making the relocation of the residents as humane and orderly as possible.

The State, through its relocation plan presented in State Court, has promised to do certain things to make the relocation humane and orderly. Without abandoning our claim that the State should have promised much more, we intend to hold the State to the promises that it has made.

The things promised by the State Health Department which are probably of the greatest interest to you as relatives and friends of the residents are the following:

- (1) The State will conduct group and individual counselling sessions with the residents to prepare them for the move.
- (2) The State will make every effort not to separate residents who share a common non-English language (for example, Chinese- and Russian-speaking residents).

- (3) The State will make every effort not to separate residents who have become close friends.
- (4) The State will relocate residents to other nursing homes that are capable of providing the level of care required by each resident.
- (5) The relatives and concerned friends of residents may, at their own expense, visit the new nursing home suggested by the State before the resident is transferred to it. If there is good reason why the family or friends do not want the resident transferred to that facility (or why the resident him/herself does not want to move there), the reason should be given to the County social worker and the State, if possible, will make other arrangements. Relatives should also know that the State has promised not to relocate residents against their will.

In making contact with residents and family members, State and County workers should always identify themselves clearly and indicate that the interview being conducted is intended to elicit information to be used for relocation purposes.

If, in your judgment, the State does not live up to one or more of its obligations in carrying out the relocation of your family member or friend, you should demand that the State abide by its promises. In addition to making such a demand, please call me at Public Advocates, 431-7430, and tell me about the State's failure.

You and your relatives and friends at the Center should be very proud of having fought so hard to maintain the San Franciscan Center for our City's elderly. We shall continue with this struggle, and will keep you informed.



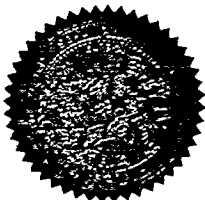

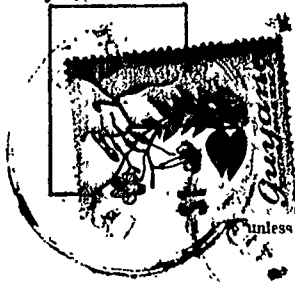
