### The Service of Ordination

- PRESIDEN MENISTER (Edward J. Melmin): James Warren Jones, you have expressed to a duly constituted ordination council, made up of elders and ministers of the Church of Jeaus Christ, your desire to be ordained as a Christian Minister. We are now to hear the report of this council.
