

: الإيا 1. That in 1974 JONES had put out an appeal for all unregistered weapons his people could acquire.

One of those attending the meeting stated she had over 170 of those weapons in her house until January 1976 when they were transferred to the church's San Francisco location.

- 2. That the weapons were subsequently taken to Guiana via chartered aircraft out of Miami.
- 3. That funds in excess of \$200,000 and \$300,000 were seen in cash in one member's home.
- 4. These monies are normally shipped via mail c/o of Paula Adams at the mission in Guiana.
- 5. That JONES is an active supporter of both the Black Muslim and Black Panther organizations.
- 6. That JONES had considerable political power, both in Mendocino and San Francisco Counties.
- 7. That JONES had aspirations toward a political appointment to Guiana, possibly an Ambassadorship.
- 8. That JONES was seen throwing tear gas into a demonstration in Guiana in 1975.
- 9. That JONES would like to become a "factor" in the Guiana government or power structure.
- 10. That he has upward of 27,000 acres in Guiana approximately 50 miles up river from Georgetown, whereupon he has his Agricultural Mission.
- 11. That he surrounded himself with a para-military type of bodyguard known as the Apostolic Guardians. Surveillance at the Redwood Valley, CA, Temple verified the presence of an armed patrol around the compound.
- 12. That he had had an agreement with the Guianese government whereby all shirments to the Agricultural Mission would be labeled as "farm implements" or "used clothing," and would not be inspected by local officials.
- 13. JONES communicates from Guiana to San Francisco in code by short wave radio.

As a result of this action, a continuing series of magazine, newspaper, radio and television articles and coverage has been given to JONES and the Church. Subsequently, investigations have been initiated by San Propercy and Mendacine countries.

JONES has retreated to Guians and is apparently selling all property here and urging his people to come to the "Promised Land."

Leokouts have been posted at Miemi, Houston, and New Orleans for ship of the destined to the mission in Guiana.

Included as Collective Exhibit 1 is a proponderance of the material printed since July 10, 1977, on this matter.

Because investigation disclosed allege' one that FONES intends to establish political power base in Guiana, and that he may currently have several hundred firearms in that country, the above information is furnished to



Earsell Bill: Called the police on my husband, Lewis Pipins, for fighting. Elsie Bell: Someone had broken into my house and taken some things out. Alfred Bell: Someone broke into my house and stole some things.. I phoned the p Corrine Mitchell: Around 69, on Rex Swank, I work for him and he would not pay me.I took him to court, he was angry that I did that and he would call my house and threaten me...so I called the police. Also one day last week there was some peoples fightening and alot of grown ups was gathering around. I thought someone would get killed so I called the police. So they came out and broke up the fight, they did not arrest antone. Also once I called the police on Ralf Hayes, from beating my daughter. Geneva S Harvey: I was moving me things from where I used to live and my ex-old man called the police and they put me in jail. You see I called the police first, but they called and they did nt put them in jail they Jimmy Rason: I got hooked up with this Mexican dude that lived next door, he was telling me an easy way to make money by transporting illegal alianes, from Mexico. So he got me into it and we went to Mexico and picked up some guys in my car. We had 4 guys and when we got to Sacramento at the check point, the police came up the car. They hand cuffed us and took us into custody. So, this Mexican guy that had me, was with me, then he told the police that he did'nt even know me, and I been knowing the guy for over a year. So I told the police that he was with me cause ahh well I tried to lie but they knew. Thats how things went down, He denied me so I told the police on him. He was the one antway that started up the whole situation. I told the police to protect myself. He was put in jail along with me. Lorine Davis: I called the police one night when I heard a baby screaming across the street. Susie Lee Collins: I called the police for a freind of mine. Irma Lee Gill: Ethel Dotson: My husband was drinking, and he had a DDt and the police came out and were talking just as nice...and they said that he was alright, that he had just had a little too much. Seorgia Lacey: Called, because someone had broken into my tenants house. and Once when someone parked their car in the drive way and I had to have it moved to get out. harweese Karshall: My sister got angry about some thing and I really did nt know what about, she went outside and was standing on the street by herself. I went out to tell her to come in and she started to run from me so I called the police to get her back. When they came, They did'nt do anything, they just passed on by her. So I went out and had to force her into my car. Her name was Maud Roberts, Jewell Jackson: I called them on my husband, We had a little difficulty and I hit him, he had a gun and I thought that he was gonna hurt me. Lola Mae CovingtonPalled when I saw some boys stealing a car.

Effice Rhetter: Called 1st when someone burglarised my home, 2cdWhen my husband was being brutal with me.3rd: when my son was on Parole and he had threatened me. Mattie Houston: Someone was trying to break into my house. Julia Birkely:Called a praloe officer on my husband cos he tried to kill me. Troy Birkely. Millie Cunningham: I was in a washroom and two men grabbed me and I got a chance to get out of there and I ran, I calle! the police and they came nad picked them up. Mena B Herring: I called them cos some man broke into my house and stole some \$. Doris Stall: Called them on a friend of mine, cos he had tickets on hiscar 3ill Pine Nina Saunders: On my neighbors next door, their grandchildren, they harass by throwing old rags. Then the mother came over and called me names. and then I called the police on the duaghter. Her mother accred with me. Mothers name: Williams, doesn't know the daughters mname. The mans name was Johnson.

<u>Minnie Sest:</u> A Jimmy Howard, I used to live with him, a social worker was sitting in our house and he came and shot his tire. I told the police that I did not know him.

Valeska Smith: Three men was smoking dope in the rear house, by the time the police got there they were gong. Another incident, Sar Moore pulled a pistal on my little nephew and cousin and I called them again. Mada Furefoy: I called them cos a man come to my house and was beating on me right in my back.

None Mae Crawford: Called the last Of March, I saw a man break into my neighbors home. he was out by the driveway filling something like a pillowcase with something. While I was on the phone with the police I saw him run back into the house and he came out with something like a big sheet, when the police arrived it was too late.

Verda Ross: called police 2 or 3 different times because there was a car in the drive way and they could not get in, and I called them before when we were in our drive way and could not get out. Altogether I have had to call them 2 or 3 times since I have been in our f family WHY DID THEY PARK IN YOUR DRIVE WAY?.... I don't know, they would leave their car there and we would have to wait and wait. Thats when the police were called. That was the only reason we phenoned the police.

Anita Pettit, When I was 13 and in a detention home in Columbus, Ohio, there was a riot distrurbance and several girls were involved, I was taken into the front office and was made to write statements against an Oriental girl saying that she had statrted it and greated disidense amongst the other inmates. Inen when I was 18 also in Columbus, Ohio, a man by the name of Spencer, that I was involved with in the streets, he had come over and I filed assult and bautery charges against him at the Police st station, because he had beaten me very badly and I was 3 month pregnant at the time. They took X rays and the Police came to the hospital and I had to go down town and file statements against him, he never did go to court. In July of 73in IA, I was gaing under the name of Denice Smith, and done several forgery, and had several charges against me for forgery. I was involved with a man called Sheldon Brown, who is now on pri son and Robert Parker was making false IDs and all thes was t turned over to the Police. There were several girls, Joanne & Sue, that I don't know their last names, and Sheldon Browns' brother, they call him Stucky, he was also picked upon drugs and checks that were stolen from whear houses which were all turned over to the Police. WHAT INFORMATION DID YOU GIVE TO THE POLICE. That Robert Parker made the false IDs, the were Ca. drivers' licenses, and where I had met Sheldon, it was over on Hobart streetand the landlord there Mr, Bob Davenport had int troduced me, to Sheldon, and he knew of all the set up and everthing, forgery. I just told them how I had met him the drugs that were involved and the police said that shelden every girl that had gone with Sheldon was stuck on drugs, he kept them on drugs.... I then turned myself into the police.

Mary Donnell: About two months ago the guy I was goinw with (he was an Older guy) I was over at a girlfriends house and he came and knocked on the door and jumped on me and I called the police on him. We got into a little hassel and he scratched me and everything and the police came out, he had left, but before he went he said that he would come back and GET me, I told the police where he lived and everything and before they left he asked (the police) if the there was any last words that I had to say, I said yes, get him and they picked him up and I thimk that they locked him up. He came by three or four weeks ago and he said see whatb you did to me, you see this paper it cost\$300.00 for me to get out of j jail. Well I said, You should int have acted up on me like that. I have int seen him since, but he is a very violent person. I've had to call the police on a couple of incidents on him, he broke my door down, the second incident they picked him up.he'll break the door down anyplace. THATS THE ONLY TIMES....yes.

Shirley Foster: My x-husband jumped on me and I called the police. Its been years, about 7. They told him that he had to leave the premisises

Marilyn: I called the police on the people that lived below ud, they was watson smoking pot and things like that, they were disturbing us and sayi they was going to kill us. All this because they knew we wanted them to move. They called the police and they had us move. We had only lived there three months, last part of July 74.

Clarence Kaisglis: My housee was broken into and I did'nt get much re sults.the police came. Feb. 24 72.

Bertha Smith: Almost 59 yrs ago I called the police to get my brother in law out of my house. and he did'nt want to get out so I called the law and the law came and made him move.

Morris Robinson: 2 yrs ago I called thepolice on 2 guys that were trying to burglarize the garage next to my house.

Tom Fitch: When I was in South Korea, I had a camera stole from me from a girl that I knew, Chung Kay Moon, she took the camera from myapt. I told the ciap and the Korean Military padice. When they found out where the camera was they were going to send her away for two yrs. So I felt sorry for her so L paid the fine and got it all sguared away.

Frank Treadway: Some people broke into our next door neighbors house& my grandma phoned the police, they come down there and ask for informat. on what they stole....

Michele Morris: Some boys come and get in the house and start to fight, so I told my mother and called the police and them the guys left. then they threatened that they were gonna get us, but they never did.

Walter wllliam Shis little boy said that he was gonna shoot me with this gun, and I called the police, they came right in, told him if he did it again that they would put him in reformatory school. 3 weeks ago.

Shirley Thomas: I called the police on my husband, told them that he was trying to hurt me. About 2 yrs ago. They just told him not to mess with

Ophelia Jacobs: I was going to work one morning and a man was standing on the sidewalk, with a gun and he pointed it across the st.so i walked down the st and told the police. I went on to work and the police went over to him, but I don't know what they did, about 6 months ago.

Stellaa Larken; Called officers cause someone was breaking into our hous this was about 3 yrs ago.

Helen Turner 71 ,I was arrested for the possesion of cocain, and the police asked me and I told them that I was not quilty, and he said then how did I get hold of it. Then I told him that Bobby Lincoln put it in my purse. That is my daughters boyfreind. Well they carried me to jail and him too. I got out on \$5,000 bail, Bobby got out on the same amount of bail, but then my lawyer sold me out and I had two yrs probation and Bob got off free.

POLICE INFORMANTS TAPE LA PT 5/10/75 TAPES SIDE ONE

Helen Turner: I used to use cocain, smoke a joint about 2,3 yrs ago.

<u>Corrine Smith</u>: I called the copd last yr on the next door neighbor, he was selling dope using, using dope and they was stealing peoples things and I was seeing it.

<u>Druecilla Hayes</u>: I drive a school bus and the 2cd semester a girl stole a taperecorder, a girl from Dorcey High, that goes to Hamilton, she stole it from the wlass room. The police asked me about it and I told them t that she had stole it.

Ruby Thompson+I called the police on my so-called daddy, cause I had been out with a man and did'nt bring home any money and at the time I was pregnant. And he would'nt let me have any dinner and he swung at me and hit me in the stomach, so I called the police. The police put me in the car and drove me around for awhile, but nothing was ever done aboutit. I once called the police on my husband, he took my son to his girlfriends house and the 2 yr old baby told off on him and the man slapped him in the face. So I called the police and they came and told him to leave the house for a couple of days. He came back, but nothing was ever done about it. The first incident was in 71% 60's.

Choicie Gordon: I was at ABC market and some boy came up and asked did I need any help to take my grocerys out to the car and I said no. By that time he had already snatched my purse out of the shopping cart and ran. I went home and told my sister and she called the police herself. The police came out and I gave them a discription of what the boy looked like and in a couple of days they came to the school ground making a big fuss. and the man on the school grounds in charge of the grounds, cameout and called the policemans and then they called me and I went down to press charges and went to court. So they just gave them a few months

Mary akin Aikens: There was a junk man in our driveway and I called the police coz he had gone to sleep in the car and I could'nt get out of t the driveway. So the police came and told him to leave , so he left and came back and when hecame back he broke a window out and went into the downstairs apt.

Nancy Clay: I called the police on a man beating up on a woman. He was calling this woman all kinds of names, it was right back of my house. He was talking about all kinds of things that he was gonna do to her and you now he could have shot at her and it could have gone right through my house and killed someone in my house. And so I called the police. this was about 13 yrs ago.

Marie Thomas: I called the police because there was a bunch of boys fighting outside of my house, it was more than one fighting one boy, so I called the police. This was before I met Father, It was more that 4 yrs ago. The police came and the guys were running all over the place.

Monica Peterson: When I returned from England In about 72, I was told there was a girl in LA that wanted to Min me, so I wouldn't work and I found that I was being followed, she was mixed up with some hoods, that is what it looked like. I went into a restaurant and I found that I was being followed, two men were in a car with knives and sort Offlike a radio. One of the girls involved, Lisa Moore and she insisted that whenever she saw me, to stop me

Manica Peterson:...or interview on a job, and all of this wame about cos someone she cared for cared for me. She has a vendeta against me...and it gets more personal more involved, but I think that this is enough to clarify....I called the police on her cos I knew that this was a girl that had never worked since she had been in Calif, and someone told me t that she was selling Cocaine, however I did not tell the police that or I did not use that expresion, and I know that she was dealing in Hot tickets. There was a close grl, a friend that flipped out and I think that she had something to do with it. (when asked by Prokes what she said to the cops she said that she used the story that the girlthat was responsible for getting another one to flip out, having whatever that does to your had, I called mainly because I had compassion for that freind of mine and partly out of vengence to the other girl) The police evedently never locked her up, Louise Watson: Called the police on my husband cos he was rude and when I left the house he tried to run over me,71, they locked him up. Helouise Hall: Boy was stealing the bucket seats out of my sons car, and anytime that there is any trouble in my neighbothood I call the police. I've called the police many times. The last time was two yrs ago. Bertha Caston: The boys broke into my house then they broke into the house across from mine, then they broke into the house behind mine, my neighbors are mad at mg and want me to tell it, but I did'nt and now they won't speak to me. Called the police 4 months ago. Ozie Mary Hollag: Nextdoor neighbor, Sept 71, boy tried to molest my daughter. In 72 daughter ran away from home, called them then and also when a car hit and ran a person Patricia Holley: In Sept, 71 the next door neighbor tried to molest me. In 73-4 I told the police on how I got raped andd we went to court, nothing ever was done. Vivian Anderson: The house was broken into when I was at work, 73.0n 7/13/73, it was broked into again. Many things were stolen and I called Father in RW that night. Mary D Jackson: Called them on a man that I was living with, He had come at me witha knife, . I had to sign a statement against him . This was 24 yrs ago. Virginia Lane: Ben Dale came into my house and stole all my things (cloths) 1959.

Robert Saffold: Someone was stealing the battery out of my car. Dy the time the police came it was too late.

Ifildred Cato: Taught piano to this little Japaneese boy, he said that the Japs were going to take over the USA. He said when they did they would be nice to the Negros.....so I reported it to the FBI. Then my deceased husbands wife came down and made some threatening statements to me: that he had never loved a Hack woman and that sort of thing.....so I called the police and they told me to call the FBI. They inture told me to protect myself. This was the 1st incident about 20 yrs ago and the 2cd incident after MMI Willie B Reed: Someone broke into my house and I called the police. Then 71 I had some disruptive tenents and I called the police on them. 65-stolen things M71-tenents incident.

Ona Peques: Called the police to protect my yard, Kids were throwing rockd in it, it's been 1yr 2cd-my ex husband threatened to set my house on fire, by bringing a gallon of gas. Then a neighbor called me at work, said that he was powring gas in my yard and was fixing to set it on fire. 69.
