The New York Times October 9, 1977 **FBI Asserts Cuba Aided Weathermen** By NICHOLAS M. HORROCK
WASHINGTON, Oct. 8 - Cuban espionage agents. . . supplied limited aid to the Weather Underground, a militant antiwar organization. . . according to a top-secret report of the Federal Bureau of Investigation. . . based upon information from the Central Intelligence Agency. . . [and] a wide range of American and foreign police agencies.

This fellow was a New York Times pipeline to the intelligence agencies!

Thus did the CIA give Leslie Mootoo his marching orders to go tell the coroner's inquest on December 13 that "at least 70 were injected." Mootoo, however, apparently still thought that he was a professional coroner, not a political puppet, so he just said what he saw -- a scene "littered with cups." HE DID NOT MENTION INJECTIONS AT ALL. (See Panel 3-2.)

By December 19, 1978, however, again as per the New York Times, Mootoo was starting to come around:

By the time Mootoo got to Scientology's Freedom Magazine (i.e., the last people the CIA needed to suspect the framing of a cult), the numbers allegedly injected now risen to "187" and still counting:
