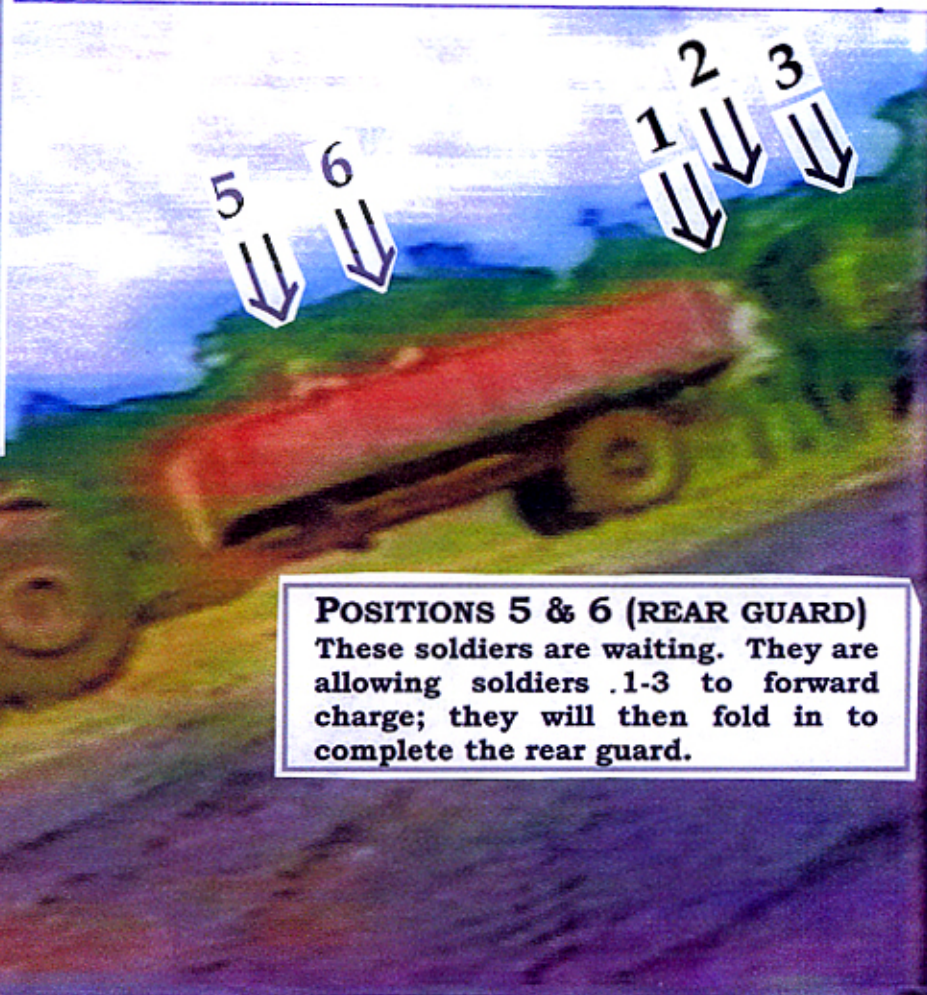


NOW LET'S SEE WHERE THE SIX POSITIONS OF THE SQUAD DIAMOND WERE PLACED ON THE ATTACK VEHICLE USING THE NBC ON-SITE FILM FOOTAGE

POSITION 1 (ASSASSIN): This soldier has disembarked first of the lead triangle of three assassins, waiting behind the trailer until positions 2 & 3 emerged, then inching to his left to take his position on the right flank of the lead assassin;

POSITION 2 (ASSASSIN): This soldier has disembarked second of the lead triangle, establishing the center of the formation, then charging forwards slightly ahead of his right and left flanks and firing the first shot;

POSITION 3 (ASSASSIN): This soldier has disembarked last of the lead triangle, circling around to take his position on the left flank of the lead assassin.

POSITION 4 (REAR GUARD)

This soldier's rifle is on "hold" between two diversionary shots, the first marking disembarkation of the lead assassin, the second marking the lead assassin's forward charge.

POSITIONS 5 & 6 (REAR GUARD)
These soldiers are waiting. They are allowing soldiers 1-3 to forward charge; they will then fold in to complete the rear guard.

NOTE: WERE BOB KICE ONE OF THE ASSASSINS, HE WOULD HAVE TO BE ONE OF POSITIONS 1-3.
