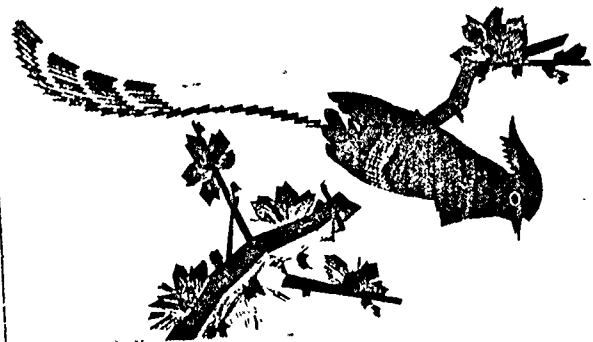

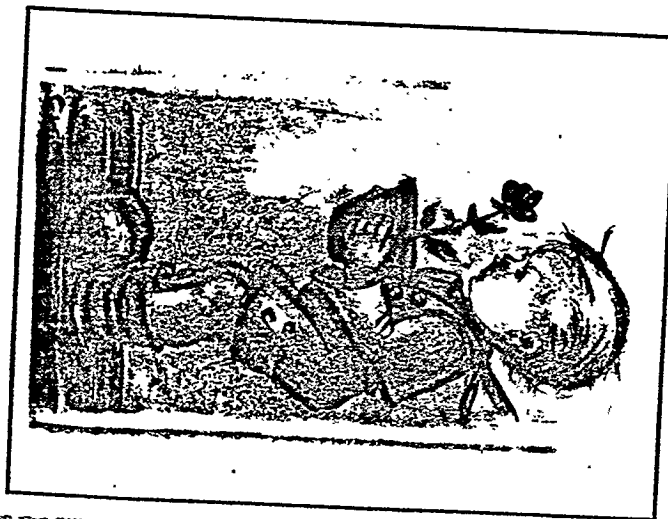

I spent about 20 minutes after supper today with the
inches and, had to go down with September 26, 1971.

Dear Hank, please excuse and forgive me for not writing so soon
since I returned, but business matters were pressing and
the time simply flew by. Sincerely, I apologize for the
light paper, but my secretary is gone and I can't find
any personal stationery anywhere. However, on the
right side, I received your lovely letter today and it had
a very pleasurable effect and my dear, it increased
my eye, which is too big already, but I do thank you
very, very much for the compliments, even though they are not
at all true, say that I had some successful men so I
wouldn't jump up on my feet and speaking of charming
people - You dear Hank, are so very charming and
lovely, lovely indeed, thank you very much indeed.

It is now 12:45 am and in about an hour I have to
take a train into Chinatown (Ross Alley) on a little
surveillance of some gambling. Our client's son has
been having his money stolen and his father feels
he is being taken by some professional and may be
in still heavily so he will watch the illegal gambling
action for a few hours and see if money is a portion of
the establishment.

I spoke with Tom at the temple in the night and
by now, you probably know that I am going to
Europe next week on business and have decided
to include Timothy O. Stoen's activities in my
London schedule. Also, ABC has agreed to furnish
a camera to document what I might find at
the banks and elsewhere. Hopefully, I will

hit the jackpot - Vegas style and bring back enough
material to indict him with, or at least, disbar him.

Although I enjoyed our several conversations on the radio,
I am truly sorry that we didn't spend more time together when
I was in Jonestown and with your permission and approval,
I shall remedy that matter when I return in late October
or early November. Then I may be spending several days in
training the people for security and hopefully make up for the
initially short visit.

He again, just got back from the surveillance and it is now
5:15 am. Everything went according to plan and my boy did
show up and dropped a very healthy haul of cash in the
game. Our team simply walked in and collected being out
and home to Daddy for what was - I didn't stay for the
parental confrontation. Anyway, he will find another game
particularly if he is addicted.

Kevin, I deeply appreciate your concerns for my wellbeing and
I assure you, I am careful in my work; but also remember, it
is the danger that makes the work interesting. But I will be
extra careful for you. Love, love, love, I am going to sleep and
address this so that it gets into the mail today, then to bed,
until 8:30 am, when my first appointment arrives.

Please take care of yourself too, I want to see a happy
healthy lady when I arrive in Jonestown. Say hello to
everyone for me and be good.

Dear Joseph

Thanks so much for your lovely letter. I am sitting here in the radio room now, and I just finished passing some medical traffic to Georgetown about a year little 9 yr. old Japanese boy who was brought in tonight to get emergency medical care. He had been bitten 2 days before by a poisonous labrid snake. His parents brought him here from down town in a canoe, and his leg was just awful. His foot was all black and his leg was swollen and very painful. Fortunately, gangrene had not set in, and we treated him with anti-toxin and anti-biotics. His temperature was 105, and we got that to come down a few degrees. He is doing much better, and we are flying him into Georgetown tomorrow. He can be hospitalized. The pain was terrible, and he was so fidgety I couldn't help but cry. I hope he can stay with us when his better - his parents said they'd like him to go to school here.

I can't say how much I enjoyed your letter - if I succeeded in forestalling your peg, you helped mine as well. Seriously, it gave me a real lift, although with your work and opportunities, I had suspected you'd forgotten me already.

I loved your description of "Sunny Day" - I just hope you will be careful when you do these things. You don't take enough concern for your own welfare. Though I know you say you'll take care of yourself, I think you like the blazer and excitement and won't be half careful enough. I'd hate to lose your friendship before I've gotten

a chance to really get to know you - as well as I want to - so no obituaries please! Hate to sound like a nagging wife about it, so I will say - no more.

By this time I guess you are back from Europe where I hope everything went well, and I hope you had gotten something that will help Mr. Finley. I don't get his just rewards. I never could stand a hypocrite and he takes the cake in that department.

Both you and I, Josephs seem to be globe-trotters. In the next couple of months I am going to be doing some purchasing for the clinic here. The episode tonight with the snake bite just pointed up once again the tremendous expense we take on for medicines, antibiotics and other kinds of medical supplies. I guess you could say we literally "paid" antibiotics and anti-venom into that little boy's leg tonight, and believe me, the things are very hard to get. I'm hoping that I will be able to find some good sources in Brazil, and possibly Venezuela. One of the disadvantages of living in a jungle is the lack of a nearby pharmaceutical supply house. Maybe you know of some persons I can contact in those two countries that could help out. If you do, please let me know. One of our nurse-practitioners is taking a patient to Venezuela tomorrow for some specialized care and I hope she will be able to find out some information. I sure don't relish being a stranger in a strange land.

Spanish. Or I'll manage. But
promise me you won't visit us
while I'm gone. I'm not very good
at expressing myself in letters, but
I am counting on your making up
for the very little time you spent
with me while you were here last
from the short time we spent
together, and from our few conversations
I find I have grown very fond of
you.

You must take care of yourself,
and promise me you will not allow
your thirst for excitement blind
you to the fact that someone
there cares for you very much, and
would be deeply hurt if anything
happened to you!

til Jan. or Feb. Wish him luck

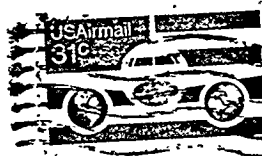

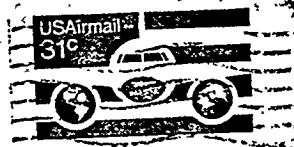
Eloise, Maggie and Carolyn are here

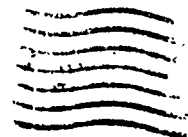

Establishment of Regional Center Priorities for 1978/79: Community Participation

The North Coast Coordinating Council and the Area I Developmental Disabilities Board have agreed to undertake a joint study of 1978/79 priorities for the Regional Center. Our purpose is to establish a firm, practical guideline that will assist the Council in deciding how to allocate its resources. Review and adjustment can be undertaken each year.

Firm recommendations must be presented to the Council at its next meeting during the latter part of May. Our recommendations will be based upon opinion and information received from individuals and groups in the community. There are different methods of collecting such data, but we believe personal contact and the opportunity for every individual to participate are vital. Therefore, given the time allowed, we have decided to mail a survey form to everyone involved and are scheduling meeting with groups such as parent associations, vendors, agency boards, staff and clients.

As a start, we have enclosed a questionnaire that lists all of the services now offered by Regional Center. A self-addressed, stamped envelope is provided for easy return. We have tried to avoid duplication but, if more than one letter arrives, please return just one response.

In thinking about priorities, remember, at this point, we are interested in community needs that can reasonably be met. What do you need now or in the near future that can or is being provided?

At a later date we will tackle the problem of long-term, unmet needs which should be addressed in our area.

We want to encourage as much participation as possible. In addition to the questionnaire, we hope people will attend our group meetings and also feel free to call or write with any comments.

Meetings with UVAH and the Del Norte Association are scheduled for March 20th and April 12th respectively. During the next two weeks, arrangements will be made to speak with others between now and the end of April. We welcome an invitation to any group meetings that people may wish to organize themselves.

Below, are listed staff who can be contacted with questions, suggestions or requests for assistance. Please be assured that the results and recommendations will be announced to the community at the conclusion of the project.

I suggest that you give this letter to Dad.

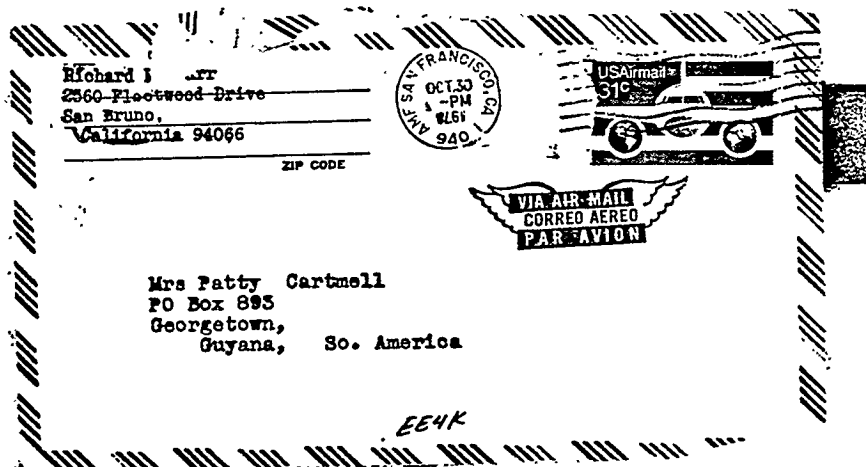

like they haven't talked in quite some time. Barb should write to her and at least let her know she and Becky are doing o.k.

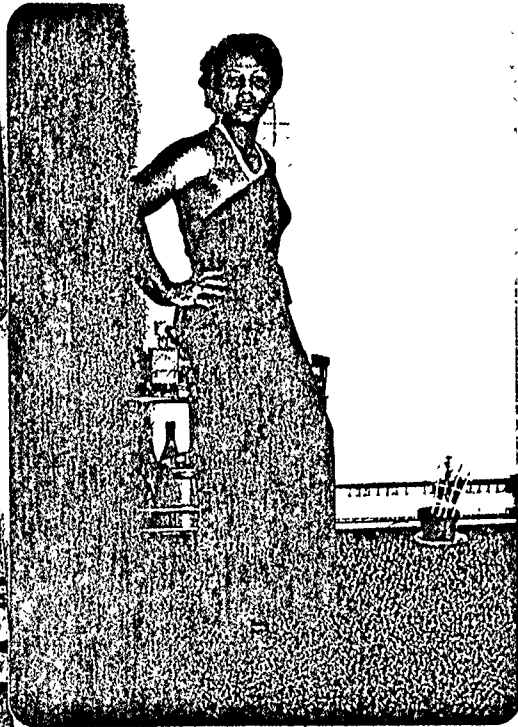
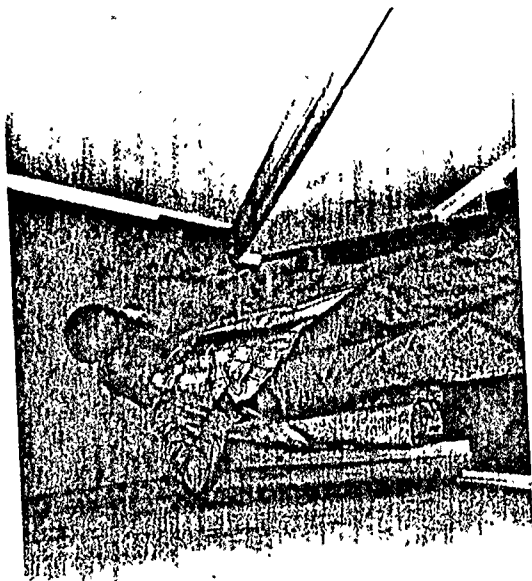

Dear Angela,

Hello Comrade! I am a member of Jonestown. I am 17 years of age and in High School. I have listened to you speak at the San Francisco Temple and have read your book. I enjoyed your speeches and appreciated hearing you speak about Black liberation and for the Peoples Freedom. All my life I have wondered if there would be any place in the world where Blacks, Indians, and minority people could go and really be free. Well, I never found the place until I came to Jonestown, Guyana. Because, in the states all Black was young people going to drugs or jail and even being killed. But here in Jonestown there is none of that, it is a very beautiful community and I would like to tell you just a little bit about it. In Jonestown we have 5 large buildings which we call dorms, about 60 cottages, a large kitchen and a main dining area where we all eat together. Surrounding Jonestown is miles and miles of jungle. It is so beautiful to look out and see nature as it should be, not infiltrated with smog and pollution - much less racism and fascism. We have about 50 dogs, 3 beautiful birds, 8 small monkeys - plus Mr Muggs (the chimpanzee), 2 horses, 16 cows, 100 pigs, 3000 chickens, 1 ant eater and many others. We serve 3 meals a day also 3 midtime meals (snacks). And many 100's of acres of food planted: Bananas, fruits, eddies, papayas, lettuce, carrots, cucumbers, sweet potatoes, just to name a few. We also have a large Cassava Mill, Piggery, Chicken House, Sawmill, Tents, Mechanic Shop and other productive things. We also have a very beautiful nursery - for the babies. There are three different rooms - one room is for babies 0-3 months, the next room is for 3-18 months, and the last room is 18 mths. to (over)

three years. The parents can leave their babies in the nursery if they want to while they go out to work. All of the babies here are very healthy. As a matter of fact in Jonestown a committed couple of people that are not to their best of health. The climate is nice and warm but there is always a cool breeze blowing. No money in the world could ever pay for this kind of a life. Many people coming from the states that are here, did not know anything about agriculture, including myself. But, I have caught on and learned, that I really love working in the warm sun; planting, weeding and picking the food, which really makes me feel good because I know that I am doing it for myself and I can actually see what I have produced it and eat it! Jonestown is undecribably beautiful. Thanks to my leader, Jim Jones, who paid my way over here. I can now live with comrades that care for me. I work in the nursery with the babies, 0-8 months and enjoy it very much. I hope that you will write us back in response to our letters. We are determined to keep our land free and committed to defending our land. We really have a beautiful land to defend and were not going to let the Capitalists come in and take over our land.

(1) Phil's immigration status is null and void. He cannot reenter the U.S. until he has applied for a new visa. ← This is his travel restrictions; nothing to do with immigration.

(2) For his immigration, Debbie will have to do the following.

a) Go to the immigration services and file an I-130 petition for a new immigration card for Philip, with his Guyana address.

It will then be sent to the London office (he estimated it will take 6 weeks); and they will in turn notify Philip here and he will have to, from here, file a petition to transfer the file to Guyana.

Philip will then have to go for an interview at the Guyana Consulate in the U.S.

(3) I told the man, a Mr. Randerberger, that Phil had told his wife to file the immigration papers last year and didn't find out until

he asked her to do so again that she had neglected to do so last year. Mr. Ranniberger said that he should have gotten a "re-entry permit" if he was going to be gone longer. I told Mr. R. that Phil didn't know he was ~~was~~ going to be gone longer than a year. I didn't get a reply to my last letter but decided to surprise you with another letter. I just arrived in Georgetown for a couple of weeks. Much to your amazement, I was able to be pulled out of my lovely cottage in the jungle so I could see some of my Guyanese friends in the capital. They come into the hinterlands to see me regularly but their invitations of reciprocity were getting a bit overdue so I decided to make the trip.

My daughter, who is now in her 2's, is doing fine and blossoming better than ever. She has a penchant for bananas and peanut butter fudge which I have a mother's habit of indulging her in. (I told you I adopted a little girl over a year ago.) She is in our toddler day-care program and has made great strides in learning that never cease to amaze me. She goes on field-trips around the farm and at two years old can identify crops we are growing and livestock we are raising. Because my work is secretarial, she at two, is more knowledgeable about the farm than I am.

I am five and, ~~and~~ with great self-discipline, am not a butterball. I have an appetite which is that of an 18 year old male so have to constantly keep it in check. I have stayed at an average of 115 lbs and don't want to gain or lose. I sent pictures last year, which I am not sure if you got because I never got a letter back. I look the same only my hair is longer.

The farm itself is a lovely community of cottages and cultural and industrial buildings. Our school is used as an example by the the Guyana educational system because

of the high academic standard and practical approach of demonstrating to students how knowledge can be used to develop a community. This is something that educators across the nation are trying to implement. Our success in that area is attributable to the harmony and peace amongst all the residents in our community. We are an egalitarian society in every sense of the word, racially, socially, and economically, so we have no petty jealousies that have plagued so many who have also tried what we have accomplished. Success at anything is the basis of all jealousies and so it goes with the lies and malicious attacks we've gotten in California. I can assure you positively, there isn't an ounce of truth to any of the lies you've read.

I talk to Tom frequently and he said he sees his parents at least once a month. They go to museums, the zoo, cultural exhibitions in the Bay area with him.

Susan and Jimmy should either be through high school or close to it. What are their plans for the future? Knowing the Neustel syndrome, Susan has a boyfriend and wants to get married.

I have been trying to contact Dr. Ali, Sarjo, Searwan & the Lab. Tech. at Mercy up until this hour I have been successful in talking with the Lab. Tech. at Mercy & Dr. Sarjo briefly. The following info I have obtained. #1 As soon as the cultures arrive here today, I will take them to Mercy & Gram stain them to find out if the problem is fungal or bacterial (the complete growth will take 2 days) but at least we would know to keep him on meds for fungus or bacterial type infection. #2 Dr. Sarjo said to keep him on the Erythromycin anyway until the culture comes back. I will keep trying the other Drs. until I talk with them today. #3 You know by radio what their ideas are. I am also sending Actifed tab. 3 x daily for 7 days to try and resolve pressure in the middle ear which will hopefully decongest the tubes giving some relief from the pain. #4 Regarding the ear syringe - I was only able to buy a bulb syringe for irrigation - not a suction type instrument. An drum is ruptured - only small amt of ear drops on swab for cleaning & drying canal. The reason I feel strong about this is because if the drum is open one can push bacteria or fungus

back up the tubes thus predisposing him to meningitis. The idea of suctioning the canal is good however, we have no suction machine or small catheters (they have been ordered on Emergency list.) The swabbing with cotton gently was my only other alternative. If the drums are ruptured they will heal with time after the infection clears. When I find out the results of the gram stain I will send out any medication we do not have there by plane (someone will have to meet it.) But I'll let you know today. Please tell Father that I'm sorry he's going thru so much pain & that I will get all opinions about the condition and let you know.

Judy James sent a note via Ruth that Mia James has a chronic urinary tract bacteremia and has been taking Macro-dantin 4x daily & vit. C 200mg qid. She is to continue for 2 mo. & then be cultured again. Would you please look in her suitcase and see if the medicine came with her. I have called about 10 drug stores and cannot locate macro-dantin. I will have to have them send it from the States if she doesn't have any with her. We do have the vit. C.

also I was told that Jason Gieg has a milk allergy and cannot eat any ^{form} of dairy products. I know in S.F. he was always congested & had runny nose. I do not know his medical history however well enough to give any recommendations.

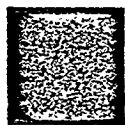

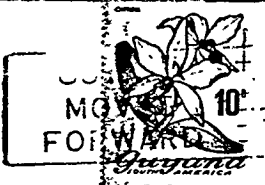

My Brother has begun to come back to Church now. The first night he come, service was nearly over before they would let him in. Leona, called me very rudely over the mike + said Larine blavis I want to see you + right now. She question me, also Alice + husband, about how my brother got to service on a Tuesday night. I told them he called me + I told him. My brother gave his home + every thing he had, they have been sleeping on the floor all winter. My brother wanted to talk to Leona + she would not talk to him. I think this was rude to call me out in the manner she did. I ask Council that she apologize to me at the wed. night meeting or if I had done any thing to let the family know about it, I was ignored again. Dear Christine - I have been putting out of my mind the writing to you - until finally there's no more room to hide it away. That sounds pretty awful - I do love you - that is true and all the rest isn't as important - but they are certainly complicated, all these feelings I have had for so long. I shall try to simplify and say that somewhere back there I lost my trust and have been fearful of being hurt so have barricaded myself with a coolness. And if that seems like an un-caring I am sorry.

I feel you are reaching out for two reasons. The first is that you are so far from "home" or familiar territory - the other that you need to reassure us about the temple and your life + to soothe everyone after all the negative press, etc. The main thing that I'm concerned about is that you are living where you are and doing what you are doing only because you want to and that you have complete freedom to change your mind + views + exercise that freedom at will - yours - and even to leave there if you want to.
