BUT HOW COULD THAT BE WITH SO MANY PEOPLE THERE? Response: Only defectors could identify the Temple, but most had already boarded. Those still on the ground were killed, wounded, or ran for cover. An eyewitness looked for Cobb and he had fled too!, later telling the press, he was "very lucky.... I was on the opposite side I saw them go down. I ran to the jungle 50 yards and dove into the jungle."

Just Edith Parks ("Biography" special) noted a difference, saying of the (real Jonestown) tractor-trailer: "It didn't worry me. Because I knew the ones on it. But <u>here</u> [meaning <u>a different vehicle</u>??] the men were hid. Then they got out and started shooting...."

Why suddenly "hide" if they were in plain sight minutes earlier? And how could <u>a driver</u> "hide" -- he's in the open air! And how can anyone "identify" men first hiding, then rifle sites covering their faces, then everyone has fallen or fled, then the assassins are gone??!!

Police were also told that survivors of the shootings at Port Kaituma airstrip, where Ryan and four others were killed, identified Stanley Gieg as the driver of a tractor that brought seven men — including at least three gunmen — into the vicinity of Ryan's plane.

The names of seven others with Gieg at the time had previously been reported: Tom Kice, Bob Kice and Joe Wilson, identified as firing weapons in the attack, and Eddie Crenshaw, Ronnie James, Ron Talley and Albert Touchette, seen riding on the trailer behind the tractor Gieg was driving.
