ASSASSIN 2:

Was this man Bob Kice?

Answer: No.

Why Not?: Too tall. But this assassin's height is more definitive than just "no Bob Kice." This rules out everyone at Jonestown!!

Note also that Assassin 1 is visibly white. Narrowing down the candidates to the white men on the FBI list, none were notably short, which is not surprising. They were all grown men; the youngest white man was Stanley Gieg, age 18, which even the FBI report describes as "5'8"". The assassin in position 1 would had to have been no taller than *five feet zero inches tall* for the taller Assassin 2 to even be as "short" as 6'7" -- topping *anyone* at Jonestown!

Kice was of course not 5'0" tall, nor was Gieg, who in fact was spotted in the driver's seat of the (real) Jonestown tractor just minutes earlier, not at the back of the long trailer!


Neither Assassin 1 nor Assassin 2 were Bob Kice; indeed due to the height discrepancy between Assassins 1 & 2, ASSASSIN 2 DECIDES THE MATTER. IT IS NOT ONLY IMPOSSIBLE THAT THAT ASSASSIN WAS BOB KICE, BUT HE WAS NO ONE FROM JONESTOWN AT ALL!!


ASSASSIN 3:


Was this man Bob Kice?

Answer: No.

Why Not?: Curvature of the spine. The few seconds that assassin 3 is clearly visible, he is continuously hunched over. This man had curvature of the spine. Not Bob Kice. Not even Tom Kice. Like all the assassins in this photo, we haven't a clue who he was.
