FOLLOW-UP QUESTIONS

DID NO ONE AT JONESTOWN EQUAL THE HEIGHT OF ASSASSIN 2?


No. The tallest were Stephan Jones (6'5",) in Georgetown at the time; and Jim McElvane (6'5", right) filmed just minutes earlier seeing off passengers in civilian dress.



BUT WEREN'T THERE OTHER TEMPLE MEN THAT SURVIVORS WERE "SURE" WERE ASSASSINS?

JUST TWO AND FOR SUBJECTIVE REASONS: TOM KICE, FELLOW GUNTOTER WITH BOB KICE; AND JOE WILSON, ACCUSED OF HAVING SLIPPED LARRY LAYTON A GUN:

TOM KICE was ruled out for the same reasons as was Bob Kice; not short enough (Assassin 1); not tall enough (Assassin 2); no curvature of the spine (Assassin 3.) JOE WILSON was a black man, described in the FBI report as six feet tall and dressed in "jeans and dirty shirt." Assassins 1 & 3 were white. The race of Assassin 2 unknown, but Wilson was hardly seven feet tall or dressed in green military camouflage!



What of the other three on the scene, rear guard 4, 5 & 6?

This was a sudden, swift, brutal, professional attack. The Congressman was killed within seconds. There was no second wave of attacks and no need. Soldier 4's function was diversionary, firing into the air while the assassins disembarked at the other end. Soldiers 5 & 6 are not yet grounded nor firing weapons. It is unlikely they fired at the victims at all.
