Mae Fields did everything she could to protect her son and his family from Jim Jones. But it wasn't enough.

Now the former Buffalo woman is alone — completely. All she has left are the pictures of her son, Donald Fields, 46, his wife, Shirley, 20; and their two children, a boy,11, and a girl, 12; all victures of last month's murdersuicide ritual in Jonestown, Guyana.

The grief and loneliness have so filled her that there is little room left for anything else, except perhaps bitterness that nobody would listen to her warnings.

Since learning that her son and his family died in the jungles of South America, Mrs. Fields has confided in one man only, Herb Brin, editor of the Los Angeles Heritage, a Jewish newspaper.

When Mr. Brin first contacted Mrs. Fields by phone, she hesitated to talk.

She broke down, however, when Mr. Brin said he had recited the kaddish, the Jewish prayer for the dead, for her grandchildren.

"She was sobbing her heart out," Mr. Brin said from his Los Angeles office. "She has nobody left. I'm her only contact with reality."

Mrs. Fields tried to reach her daughter-in-law's parents, but they didn't want to talk about the tragedy, <u>Mr. Brin said</u>.

Donald Fields was born and reared in Buffalo. He graduated from School, 74, Mastern Park High School and, in 1955, the University of Buffalo School of Pharmacy. After spending two years in the Army, he returned to Buffalo in 1957 or 1958 to begin working as a pharmacist.

He worked at two local pharmacies before he, his father, Robert, a bus driver, and his mother moved to Los Angeles, in 1962. Robert Fields died three years ago. Donald Fields went to work as a pharmacist in California. He met Shirley Miller, a teacher, there, and they got married about 13 years ago. They appeared to be a typical Jewish couple, Mr. Brin said. Their personal tragedy began about two years ago, when Donald's wife claimed she had stomach cancer. A friend told her about Jim Jones and his Peoples Temple, and she went to see him.

Shirley Fields claimed Jones had cured her, and she became a convert. Soon she persuaded Donald to join her and tiper children in the Peoples Temple, Mr. Brin said.

Donald quit his job, sold his family's house and belongings and by the summer of 1977 had followed his wife and children to Jonestown, Mr. Brin said.

According to Mr. Brin, Donald's mother knew Jones was a phony from the start. But her pleas to congress

men and religious agencies failed to arouse much interest.

However, Mr. Brin said, the members of the Peoples Temple joined of their own free will, and there wasn't much that, government or religious agencies could do.

Nevertheless, the refusals and inability to help have left Mrs. Fields, bitter, Mr, Brin said.


"I pleaded for help, but nobody listened," Mr. Brin quoted Mrs. Fields as saying. "Our children were in trouble, and everybody passed the buck."

If anything positive is to come out of her suffering, he said, it must be an awareness to guard against cults and their efforts to ensnare those who are looking for something to believe in.

"Her tears must be heard by other Jewish parents around the country and by all others who are taken in by cults," Mr. 'Brin said. "This is not going to be the last case of tears."

She advised that she departed the US in 1977, with a group of PT members in late 1977 for Georgetown, Guyana. After arriving in Georgetown, Guyana, she departed for Jonestown several days later aboard the PT vessel, Cudjole

At Jonestown, she stated that she worked in the fields, farming, and assisted in the Jonestown School, which was run by THOMAS GURBBS. PURSLEY stated that during this time, she was instructed by the PT hierarchy to marry a PT member in Jonestown, which she did over her personal objections.M

PURSLEY stated that shortly before the arrival of Congressman RYAN and his party in November, 1978, she was ordered to leave Jonestown to escort a group of elderly PT members going to Georgetown for medical and dental treatment. PURSLEY said that at the time of RYAN's death on November 18, W
