On 11/18/78, at 8:30 pm, Special Agent [Redacted] Department of State, Washington, D. C., telephonically advised the writer that he had "flash" information from the American embassy in the African country of Guyana that the above captioned individual while boarding a small airplane along with approximately 8 to 10 other individuals were attacked by a truck-load of "whites."

[Redacted] stated that as of this time the information regarding RYAN's demise was unsubstantiated.
