THE SECT, ACCORDING TO [REDACTED] HAS TWO RADIO STATIONS, ONE IN GEORGETOWN, GUYANA, AND ONE IN THE INTERIOR OF GUYANA. THE GEORGETOWN STATION HAS A CALL DESIGNATOR

WB6MNH/8R1, AND THE INTERIOR STATION HAS A CALL DESIGNATOR WB6MID/8R3. ACCORDING TO [REDACTED] THE WB6MNH DESIGNATES AN AMERICAN LICENSE HOLDER IN CALIFORNIA. THE 8R1 DESIGNATES GUYANA. THE LICENSE HOLDER IS SUPPOSED TO OPERATE THE TRANSMISSIONS FROM GUYANA WITH THE PERMISSION OF GUYANA. ALFRED TOUCHETTE, REDWOOD CITY, CALIFORNIA, AS MENTIONED IN INFORMATION PROVIDED BY [REDACTED] - NBC NEWS, IN REFERENCED CHICAGO TELETYPE, IS LIKELY TO BE THE LICENSE HOLDER FOR THE RADIO LICENSES FOR THE SECT.) IN THE EVENING OF APRIL 30, 1978, [REDACTED] OVERHEARD A STRONG RADIO SIGNAL WHICH CONSISTED OF RADIO TRAFFIC IN MEDICAL TERMINOLOGY. INFORMATION WAS BEING RELAYED FROM A DOCTOR. [REDACTED] AFTER THE TRANSMISSION, CONTACTED THE INDIVIDUAL TRANSMITTING, ALONG WITH ANOTHER 20 HAM RADIO OPERATORS. [REDACTED] STATED THAT HE CONTACTED THE INTERIOR RADIO STATION. THE INDIVIDUAL ON THE INTERIOR RADIO STATION WHO SOUNDED LIKE A DOCTOR, WAS NAMED DREW (PHONETIC) (LAST NAME UNKNOWN). THE FIRST CONVERSATION WAS BETWEEN 1:38 AM AND 1:44 AM, ON APRIL 30, 1978. A SECOND CONVERSATION ON APRIL 30, 1978, OCCURRED BETWEEN 10:13 PM AND 10:25 PM. THIS (u)

CONVERSATION WAS WITH THE GEORGETOWN RADIO STATION, AND

[] SPOKE WITH A BOB (LNU), AN INDIVIDUAL HE BELIEVED TO BE IN HIS 20'S. (u)

[] SUBSEQUENTLY RECEIVED, IN WHAT HE BELIEVED WAS MAY, 1978, AN ARROWGRAM (SIMILAR TO A MAILGRAM). THIS COMMUNICATION REGRETTED THE DELAY IN SENDING A QSL CARD, A CONFIRMATION OF A RADIO TRANSMISSION. THE ARROWGRAM EXPLAINED THE PURPOSE OF THE PEOPLE'S TEMPLE AGRICULTURE MISSION. IN WHAT [] BELIEVED WAS JUNE, 1978, THE QSL CARD WAS RECEIVED, AND IT WAS SIGNED BOB AND PAULA ADAMS, P.O. BOX 893, GEORGETOWN, GUYANA, SOUTH AMERICA. (u)

[] STATED THAT HE DID NOT HAVE PATCHING CAPABILITIES.

[] STATED THAT MANY HAM RADIO OPERATORS HAVE THAT CAPABILITY, AND MANY OF THE RADIO OPERATORS RECORD THEIR CONVERSATIONS. [] STATED THAT THE WORD IS OUT, AND THAT MANY OPERATORS WILL LIKELY COME FORTH WITH INFORMATION.

[] STATED THAT HE TELEPHONED THE FBI IN RESPONSE TO THE LOCAL NBC NEWS BROADCAST. (u)

[] STATED THAT THE SECT WAS USING A YAESU-MODEL 101EE RADIO TRANSMITTER AND A MOSLEY CL36 COMMERCIAL ANTENNA. (u)

DR. [REDACTED] ADVISED ON NOVEMBER 20, 1978, THAT HE HEARD THE EVENING NEWS AND FELT THAT THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION MIGHT BE OF SOME ASSISTANCE IN THE ABOVE INVESTIGATION: (u)

LIBRARIAN. FOREIGN NAMES WERE LISTED ON THE LETTERHEAD AS MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL. THESE INDIVIDUALS WERE LAWRENCE E. SCHACHT, M.D., SHARON R. COBB, R.N., PNP, JOYCE A. PARKS, R.N., F.N.P., AND DALE PARKS, C.R.T.T. (u)
