At 3:50 a.m. on November 20, 1978, Special Agent (SA) [redacted] was called to the operating room at the Malcolm Grow Medical Center, Andrews Air Force Base by Doctor [redacted] who had just completed surgery on victim JACKIE SPEIERS. Doctor [redacted] gave SA [redacted] small fragments of an unknown caliber bullet on a gauze pad. Also, Doctor [redacted] provided a 2½ to 3 inch long strip of grayish material, also on a gauze pad, which he said he removed from Miss SPEIERS' forearm. Doctor [redacted] stated that the material appeared to be of a plastic composition, possibly from luggage. Doctor [redacted] stated that the victim was in very critical condition and was being returned to the intensive care unit. (u)

The victim sustained at least two wounds to the upper right arm, at least two to the upper right thigh

Doctor [redacted] and Doctor [redacted] both stated that the wounds sustained by Miss SPEIERS were from a high velocity weapon, possibly an M16 or similar type weapon. Miss SPEIERS' condition was complicated [redacted]

[redacted] She had a "massive injury which will require her removal to the Brooks Army Medical Center in San Antonio, Texas where she will be placed in a hyperbolic oxygen chamber to combat the rapidly spreading infection." (u)
