KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, AMATEUR RADIO CALL SIGN  PREVIOUSLY CONTACTED THE FBI OFFICE, KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, AND ADVISED THAT HE HAD COMMUNICATED WITH BEA TOUCHETTE, AMATEUR RADIO STATION CALL SIGN W6GMID/8R3, PEOPLES TEMPLE AGRICULTURAL MISSION, JONESTOWN, GUIANA, ON 14 MHZ, SINGLE SIDE BAND, ON SEPTEMBER 13, 1978. THE CONTACT WAS SHORT AND INVOLVED AN EXCHANGE OF NAMES, LOCATIONS, SIGNAL STRENGTH INFORMATION AND WEATHER INFORMATION. THERE WERE NO POLITICAL OVERTONES TO THE CONTACT.  LATER APPEARED AT THE KANSAS CITY OFFICE (u)
