HEATH, OHIO, ADVISED HE IS AN AMATEUR RADIO OPERATOR AND HAS FREQUENTLY HEARD CONVERSATIONS BETWEEN AMATEUR STATIONS W6DVI AT STOCKTON, CALIFORNIA, AND W6MID, PORTABLE 8R1 OR PORTABLE 8RC OPERATING IN GUYANA. MR. [REDACTED] NOTED W6DVI WAS ISSUED TO

AND W6MID WAS ISSUED TO ALBERT A. TOUCHETTE, 347 ROAD B, REDWOOD VALLEY, CALIFORNIA. MR. [REDACTED] ADVISED THE CALL 8R IS USED ON STATIONS OPERATING IN GUYANA. THE CONVERSATIONS WERE MOST OFTEN HEARD ON TWO FREQUENCIES, 14344.2 MEGAHERTZ AND 14324.7 MEGAHERTZ. (u)

MR. [] ADVISED HE FIRST RECALLS HEARING THESE CONVERSATIONS AROUND MAY, 1978, AND WAS ATTRACTED TO THEM BECAUSE OF THEIR LENGTH AND THE FACT THEY SPOKE IN CRYPTIC LANGUAGE, BOTH OF WHICH ARE CONTRARY TO FCC RULES. HE STATED IT WOULD FREQUENTLY BE ASKED, "QSL", WHICH IN HAM RADIO LANGUAGE MEANS, "DO YOU UNDERSTAND?" SOMETIMES THE RECEIVING PARTY WOULD BE GONE FOR A PERIOD OF TIME AND THEN RETURN TO THE RADIO AND REPLY, "QSL", INDICATING THE MESSAGE WAS UNDERSTOOD. (u)

MR. [] FURTHER STATED THE CONVERSATIONS WERE GENERALLY ABOUT PURCHASES OF RICE, MEDICINE OR MACHINE SHOP SUPPLIES. HE NOTED THEY APPARENTLY WERE PURCHASING LARGE MACHINE SHOP EQUIPMENT SUCH AS GRINDERS AND MILLING MACHINES. IT WAS ALSO MENTIONED THAT THEY WERE STORING FOOD UNDERGROUND. ONE CONVERSATION RELATED TO THE PURCHASE OF RAZOR BLADES AND IT WAS MENTIONED THEY WERE EXPERIMENTING WITH THE SHARPENING OF BLADES. IT WAS ALSO MENTIONED THAT THEY HAD BUILT "PYRAMIDS" FOR THE STORAGE OF FOOD AND EQUIPMENT. HE STATED HE NEVER HEARD ANY MENTION OF THE PURCHASE OF GUNS OR FIREARMS TRAINING AND, ALTHOUGH HE HEARD SOME REFERENCE TO A TROUBLE MAKER NAMED MARTHA, HE CANNOT RECALL ANY MENTION OF PLANS TO HARM PUBLIC OFFICIALS. MR. [] SAID THEY (u)

SPOKE MOST FREQUENTLY OF DOCTORS AND IT WAS HIS IMPRESSION
THERE WERE MANY DOCTORS ASSOCIATED WITH THE PROJECT. IT WAS ALSO
NOTED THE GUYANA STATION HAD TALKED ON OCCASION TO A STATION IN
FLORIDA AND ONE IN EITHER IOWA OR NEBRASKA. ONE PERSON
FREQUENTLY HEARD WAS APPARENTLY THE FATHER OF A GIRL IN GUYANA
AND HE DID MOST OF THE BUYING FOR THE CHURCH. (u)

MR. [REDACTED] NOTED THE FCC MAY HAVE TAPES OF SOME OF THESE
CONVERSATIONS WHICH WERE MADE BY A MONITORING STATION. (u)
