SUBJECT: US MILITARY SUPPORT TO GUYANA INCIDENT

REF: JCS 252334Z NOV 78 (NOTAL)

1. STATE DEPARTMENT CONCURS WITH INITIATION REDEPLOYMENT FROM GUYANA. HOWEVER, FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS AND POTENTIAL REQUIREMENTS SHOULD BE KEPT IN MIND IN PLANNING FIRST STAGES REDEPLOYMENT.

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2M WE BELIEVE IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT FINAL SEARCH JONESTOWN SETTLEMENT AND SURROUNDING CLEARED AREAS BE MADE BY AMERICAN MILITARY PERSONNEL ACCOMPANIED BY EMBASSY PERSONNEL TO ASSURE THAT ALL BODIES HAVE BEEN RECOVERED. THIS SEARCH SHOULD BE MADE IN DAYLIGHT.

3. EMBASSY HAS RESPONSIBILITIES FOR INVENTORY OF PROPERTY IN JONESTOWN AND ASSISTANCE IN SECURING MOVABLE ASSETS. DOD TRANSPORT AND OTHER ASSISTANCE WILL BE REQUIRED.

4. GOG HAS REQUESTED TRANSPORT ASSISTANCE IN ITS ROLE OF SUPPLYING PHYSICAL SECURITY TO JONESTOWN AND IS CONTINUING INVESTIGATION DURING NEXT FEW WEEKS. THIS REQUEST NOW BEING ADDRESSED BY VARIOUS USG AGENCIES AND WE ANTICIPATE

DECISION WITHIN 40 HOURS. U.S. INVESTIGATIVE PERSONNEL MAY ALSO REQUIRE AIR TRANSPORT.

5. REQUIREMENT MAY EXIST FOR EVACUATION SURVIVORS, INCLUDING THOSE NOW HOSPITALIZED.

6. THERE MAY BE OTHER REQUIREMENTS WHICH EMBASSY MAY IDENTIFY.

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7. NEVERTHELESS, IT WOULD APPEAR THAT SOME DOD ASSETS
NOW IN GUYANA ARE NO LONGER NEEDED AND SUCH ASSETS MAY
BE REDEPLOYED PENDING COMPLETE ANALYSIS ADDITIONAL RE-
QUIREMENTS. IN PARTICULAR REDEPLOYMENT GRAVES REGISTRA-
TION UNIT, SOME PERSONNEL AND SOME HELICOPTERS SHOULD
PROCEED IN COORDINATION WITH AMB/ BURKE. CHRISTOPHER

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
