THE FBI PROVIDED ONE SPECIAL AGENT AT EACH LOCATION NOTING THAT THEIR ROLE WOULD BE STRICTLY ONE OF AN OBSERVER FOR CAPTIONED MATTER (u)

THE SEARCH AT ENOLA M. NELSON REALTY COMPANY
WHERE MC ELVANE IS A SALESMAN REVEALED THE FOLLOWING
ITEMS IN A DESK WHOSE USER IS NOT KNOWN: (u)

ONE HOAX BOMB WHICH CONSISTED OF TWO D-CELL
BATTERIES, APPROXIMATE THREE-AND-ONE-HALF-INCH BY
ONE-AND-ONE-HALF-INCH GALVANIZED PIPE THREADED
AT BOTH ENDS BUT NO END CAPS, ENDS BEING TAPED
OVER WITH BLACK ELECTRICAL TAPE, ONE WESTCLOCK
ALARM CLOCK, WHITE FACE WITH BLACK LETTERS, WITH
WIRES RUNNING FROM BATTERY TO CLOCK TO PIPE.
THIS DEVICE WAS EXAMINED BY THE LOS ANGELES POLICE
DEPARTMENT BOMB SQUAD AND FOUND TO BE A HOAX DEVICE.
THE CONTENTS OF THE PIPE WERE SOME TYPE OF PLASTIC (u)
