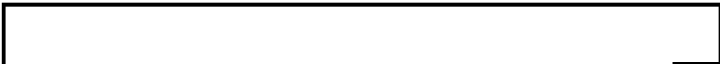

AN AMATEUR RADIO OPERATOR, CALL LETTERS [REDACTED], CONTACTED NOV. 26, 1978, AND ADVISED HE HAS CONTACTED WB6 MID/8R3, JONESTOWN, GUYANA, SOUTH AMERICA, ON THREE DIFFERENT OCCASIONS BY RADIO. [REDACTED]

BECAME AWARE OF WB6 MID/8R3 BY MONITORING THEIR TRAFFIC ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS, A LOT OF IT BEING MEDICAL TRAFFIC BY A FEMALE AT JONESTOWN WHO APPEARED TO BE A NURSE. (u)

[REDACTED] FIRST CONTACT WITH WB6 MID/8R3 WAS ON JAN. 30, 1978, AT 1:05 A.M. FOR APPROXIMATELY 15 MINUTES. HE TALKED WITH ALBERT

TOUCHETTE, WHO INDICATED HE WAS A MISSIONARY WITH A CHRISTIAN CHURCH.

TALKED AT LENGTH ABOUT THE AGRICULTURAL PROBLEMS AT JONESTOWN AND THE PROBLEM THEY WERE HAVING WITH GROWING PAPAYAS (u)

[] NEXT CONTACT WITH JONESTOWN WAS ON MARCH 18, 1978, AT 1:20 A.M. WHEN HE TALKED WITH ALBERT TOUCHETTE FOR FIVE MINUTES. THIS WAS ONLY AN EXCHANGE OF QSL (CAN YOU ACKNOWLEDGE RECEIPT).

[] NEXT CONTACT WITH WB6 MID/8R3 WAS ON SEPT. 25, 1978, AND HE TALKED WITH LEE LNU FOR 15 MINUTES. LEE TALKED ABOUT MISSION PROBLEMS AND STATED THAT HE THOUGHT THEY HAD SOLVED THE PAPAYA PROBLEM (u)

ON ONE OCCASION [] ASKED TOUCHETTE IF THEY COULD USE INTERNATIONAL POSTAGE COUPONS AND TOUCHETTE STATED THEY COULD USE GREENBACKS. [] SENT A \$1 CONTRIBUTION AS HE WANTED A QSL CARD FROM JONESTOWN. [] DID RECEIVE TWO QSL CARDS; THE MESSAGE WAS THE SAME ON BOTH. ONE WAS HANDWRITTEN AND ONE TYPED. BOTH CARDS WERE SIGNED BY ALBERT (u)

[] STATED THAT IN RADIO TRAFFIC TOUCHETTE WAS A VERY ARTICULATE INDIVIDUAL. HE ALSO INDICATED NO MENTION WAS EVER MADE OF ANY WEAPONS. THE ONLY THING THAT APPEARED STRANGE TO [] WAS THE FACT THAT JONESTOWN WAS ALWAYS STATING HOW APPRECIATIVE THEY WERE OF THE HELP THEY WERE RECEIVING FROM GUYANA GOVERNMENT (u) ARMED AND DANGEROUS; SUICIDAL TENDENCIES. (u)
