KNOW AT THIS TIME THAT THE RADIO STATION WAS, IN FACT, THE PEOPLES TEMPLE. HE ADVISED THAT HE HAD FREQUENT CONTACT, AT ABOUT ONCE A WEEK, TO GET NEWS FROM HIS HOMELAND. HE LAST VISITED GUYANA IN JULY, 1977, BUT HAD NO CONTACT WITH ANYONE FROM THE PEOPLES TEMPLE. HE ASKED FOR A CONFIRMATION OF RADIO CONTACT CARD TO BE SENT HIM IN SEPTEMBER, 1978, AND RECEIVED SAME ON SEPTEMBER 29, 1978, FROM THE PEOPLES TEMPLE AT WHICH TIME HE REALIZED THAT THE TEMPLE AND RADIO STATION WERE ONE IN THE SAME (u)

HE ADVISED THAT HE TALKED WITH THREE DIFFERENT INDIVIDUALS; SARA (LNU); BEA (LNU); AND AL TOUCHETTE. ALL OF HIS CONTACTS WERE FRIENDLY, AND THEY ONLY HAD GENERAL CONVERSATIONS WITH INVITATIONS FOR HIM TO VISIT THEM IN GUYANA. HE ADDED THAT, SINCE HE WAS A NATIVE, THEY PARTICULARLY WANTED HIM TO VISIT. LAST CONTACT BY [REDACTED] WAS ON SEPTEMBER 30, 1978, NO FURTHER CONTACTS. ALTHOUGH AN ATTEMPT WAS MADE BY [REDACTED] TO CONTACT ANYONE IN GUYANA AFTER THE TRAGEDY BECAME KNOWN. [REDACTED] STATED THAT HE WAS NOT INFORMED OF THE SUSPENSION OF THAT STATION BY THE FCC, BUT HAD HEARD ABOUT IT FROM OTHER OPERATORS. HE STATED THAT IT WAS NOT PUBLISHED IN THE AMERICAN RADIO RELAY LEAGUE MAGAZINE, AND WAS NOT AN OFFICIAL SUSPENSION TO HIS KNOWLEDGE. [REDACTED] COULD PROVIDE NO (u)
