BEING HANDLED BETWEEN WB6MNH8R3 AND ANOTHER AMATEUR RADIO STATION  
SOMEWHERE IN CALIFORNIA. OPERATOR OF THAT RADIO STATION IN  
GUYANA WAS CORDIAL, AND HE IDENTIFIED THE OPERATOR AS PAULA ADAMS.

BY ONE AMATEUR OF ANOTHER AND INCLUDED WEATHER, EQUIPMENT IN RADIO STATION, AND SIGNAL REPORTS. DURING THE TIME HE MONITORED THE TRANSMISSIONS BETWEEN THE STATION IN JONESTOWN, GUYANA, AND THE UNKNOWN RADIO STATION IN CALIFORNIA, THERE WERE SOME REMARKS MADE ABOUT INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS APPARENTLY EN ROUTE TO GUYANA AND HAD NOT ARRIVED YET. HE COULD SUPPLY NO FURTHER INFORMATION RE THIS INVESTIGATION. (u)

ON NOV. 29, 1978, CAPT. [REDACTED] BERLIN PD, BERLIN, WISCONSIN, ADVISED THAT A [REDACTED] REDGRANITE, WISCONSIN, FURNISHED PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION OF HER MISSING SON, [REDACTED] WHO HAS NOT BEEN SEEN OR HEARD FROM SINCE AUGUST, 1977, AND WAS LAST KNOWN TO BE EN ROUTE TO CALIFORNIA. THE MOTHER SUSPECTS HE MAY BE ONE OF THE INDIVIDUALS WHO COMMITTED SUICIDE IN GUYANA. HE IS DESCRIBED AS W/M, DOB [REDACTED] SSAN [REDACTED] SERVED IN U.S. NAVY IN MID 60'S AND HAD MILITARY SERIAL NO. [REDACTED] SHOULD HAVE FINGERPRINTS ON FILE IN IDENT DIVISION. (u)
