SOMETIME IN 1961, HOWEVER, JONES ABRUPTLY QUIT THAT POSITION AND LEFT THE U.S. HE TRAVELED TO HAWAII AND BRAZIL, AND HIS ITINERARY IS DOCUMENTED BY POSTCARDS MAILED BY JONES TO CARTMELL'S MOTHER. JONES LATER RETURNED TO THE U.S. DURING THE WINTER OF 1963 (u)
