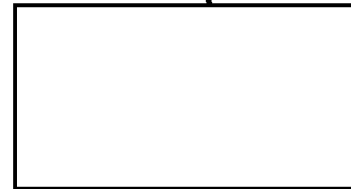

HAVE BEEN IN CONTACT WITH THE PT. [REDACTED] STATED THAT HIS CURRENT PUBLICATION OF THE HAM CALL BOOK FOR AMATEUR RADIO OPERATORS FAILED TO LIST STATION WB4IWO. [REDACTED] STATED THAT THE MANAGER FOR THE MERRITIME MOBILE NET WHICH COVERS K4CG NET IS [REDACTED], ANGLETON, TEXAS.

[REDACTED] ALSO STATED THAT A [REDACTED], ORLANDO, FLORIDA, [REDACTED] AN AMATEUR RADIO OPERATOR, MIGHT HAVE INFORMATION CONCERNING RADIO TRAFFIC BETWEEN HAMS AND THE PT BECAUSE OF HIS GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION.

IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT ON NOVEMBER 21, 1978, A HAM OPERATOR IN PHOENIX, ARIZONA, OVERHEARD A STATION REQUESTING ALL NET MEMBERS TO SEND ANY TAPES THEY MAY HAVE OF ANY PT CONVERSATIONS TO A HAM IN SAFETY HARBOR, FLORIDA. THE HAM OPERATOR BELIEVED THE REQUESTOR WAS KV4IJ, ST. CROIX, VIRGIN ISLANDS, AND BELIEVES WB4IWO, SAFETY HARBOR, FLORIDA, WAS TO RECEIVE TAPES FOR A FEDERAL AGENCY.
