Dieterich's source said that Jones' doctor had seen him three months ago and Jones had a 103 degree fever which kept running up to the time of his death. Jones suffered back the fainting spells and may have been suffering from urinary retention. Dr. Schacht recently has arranged for Jones to be examined by a doctor in the Soviet Embassy at Guyana and the Soviet doctor as well as said Jones should be hospitalized.

Jones said he could not afford to be hospitalized until after the Ryan visit. The Soviet doctor arranged for a full physical examination of Jones in either Moscow or Havannah.
