See On 12/1/78, at approximately 3:15 p.m., Mr. [redacted] appeared at FBIHQ to obtain a copy of Congressman Leo Ryan's autopsy report and death certificate. Release of these documents had been previously approved. Mr. [redacted] is a member of Congressman Ryan's Office Staff, 137 Cannon House Office Building, Washington, D. C., telephone number 225-3532. Mr. [redacted] resides at [redacted] Falls Church, Virginia. He was asked for and displayed his current Virginia drivers license as identification. *(u)*

Mr. [redacted] said he would make inquiries among other members of Congressman Ryan's staff as to the location of Ryan's briefcase, which Ryan had taken to Guyana. It was explained to Mr. [redacted] that the FBI wishes to review the contents of Ryan's briefcase for any information of value to captioned investigation. Mr. [redacted] said he would promptly contact the Command POST, FBIHQ, if he learns who is holding the briefcase. *(u)*
