DETAILS: On 11/22/78, [Redacted] Bureau of Inter-American Affairs, State Department, advised Liaison Officer [Redacted] that a ham radio operator, [Redacted] telephoned the State Department that date to advise that during the past year he had radio communications with Albert Touchette from Guyana. He said they exchanged cards by mail containing bits of personal information, a typical practice of ham operators. Touchette indicated to [Redacted] that he was working to assist the government of Guyana in humanitarian ways in an attempt to provide better conditions for the Guyanese. Touchette's address was Box 893, Georgetown, Guyana, S. A. b6
