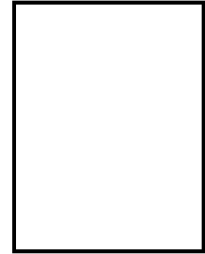

LOCAL MERCHANTS WERE NOT AWARE OF THE PEOPLE'S TEMPLE BEING IN THE AREA. ACTIVITY WAS OBSERVED AT THE REAR OF 4807 SOUTH WESTERN. A U-HAUL TRUCK WAS BACKED INTO THE REAR OF 4807 SOUTH WESTERN, AND A MALE NEGRO APPROXIMATELY THIRTY YEARS, 5' 10", 200 POUNDS, WAS OBSERVED LOADING CHAIRS AND MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS ONTO THE U-HAUL TRUCK. THIS TRUCK BORE GEORGIA LICENSE JA2743 ON THE REAR AND OKLAHOMA PLATE 8E1616 ON THE FRONT. (u)
