[REDACTED] AND LISTENED TO A CONVERSATION ON HIS RADIO WHICH HE TAPED, WHICH WAS HIS NORMAL CUSTOM. HE RECEIVED THE TRANSMISSION BETWEEN 14.350 AND 14.400 MEGAHERTZ. THE TAPE IS PRESENTLY LOCKED IN HIS RADIO ROOM AT HIS RESIDENCE IN [REDACTED] TO THE BEST OF [REDACTED] RECOLLECTION, AN UNIDENTIFIED MALE WAS TALKING TO HIS WIFE IN CALIFORNIA WHO HAD THE CALL SIGN K6..., LAST THREE CHARACTERS UNRECALLED. THE UI MALE WAS TRANSMITTING FROM A SOUTH AMERICAN COUNTRY, NAME RECALLED, AND CLAIMED TO BE THE LEADER OR ONE OF THE LEADERS OF THE PEOPLES' TEMPLE. THE TRANSMISSION WAS IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE. [REDACTED] RECALLS THE TRANSMISSION BECAUSE IT WAS IN SINGLE SIDE BAND IN A FREQUENCY RANGE NORMALLY RESERVED FOR TELETYPE OR DOUBLE SIDE BAND. THE UI MALE TOLD HIS WIFE THAT HE HAD PROBLEMS, AND WAS BEING SNIPED UPON BY UNKNOWN INDIVIDUALS. THE UI MALE BELIEVED THAT THE US CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY WAS TRYING TO ASSASSINATE HIM AND HE HAD DOCUMENTARY PROOF THAT THE CIA WAS OUT TO "GET HIM" AND HIS ORGANIZATION. THE UI MALE ALSO TALKED ABOUT UNKNOWN BANKERS IN NEW YORK CITY AND THE NEED FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING; HE MENTIONED THE NAME OF THE GOVERNOR OF AN UNKNOWN STATE, POSSIBLY NEW YORK AND AN UNKNOWN RESIDENT OF TEXAS; HE MENTIONED THAT HE HAD BEEN RUN OUT OF THE US; HE ALSO TALKED TO AN UI FEMALE

BELIEVED TO BE A NEWSPERSON ON THE RELEASABILITY OF THIS INFORMATION; AND HE TOLD HIS WIFE THAT HE HOPED TO HAVE A CHANCE TO SEE HER AGAIN, SPIRITUALLY, IF NOT OTHERWISE. [REDACTED] HAD NO OTHER INFORMATION REGARDING THE TAPE OR THE CONVERSATION.

[REDACTED] FURTHER STATED THAT UPON TAPING THIS INFORMATION, HE NOTIFIED THE FBI IN NASHVILLE AND HAS NOT HEARD FROM THEM SINCE. HE ALSO STATED HE WAS WILLING TO RETURN TO THE US AND RECOVER THIS TAPE FOR US AUTHORITIES BUT THAT DUE TO HIS WIFE'S NERVOUS CONDITION NO MI AGENTS OR POLICE SHOULD BOTHER HER AS SHE MIGHT HAVE A HEART ATTACK OR NERVOUS BREAKDOWN.

FOLLOWING [REDACTED] DEPARTURE, COL JENSEN INFORMED THE UNDERSIGNED THAT HE FELT [REDACTED] WAS AN OUTSTANDING NCO, THAT HE HAD BEEN TRUTHFUL AND THAT JENSEN BELIEVED WHAT [REDACTED] HAD TOLD THE UNDERSIGNED. JENSEN VOLUNTEERED TO ALLOW [REDACTED] TO CALL HIS WIFE AND GOVERNMENT EXPENSE IN ORDER TO HAVE HER SEND THE TAPES TO HER HUSBAND AND/OR TO ALLOW [REDACTED] TO RETURN TO THE US ON TDY IF THE UNDERSIGNED THOUGHT IT WAS NECESSARY. BOTH OFFERS WERE DECLINED AT THIS TIME. BOTH JENSEN AND [REDACTED] WERE ADVISED THAT THEY SHOULD NOT DISCUSS THIS MATTER WITH ANYONE ELSE; THAT THEY SHOULD DO NOTHING AT THIS TIME BECAUSE THAT MATTER HAD BEEN REPORTED AND WOULD BE FORWARDED

BY THE UNDERSIGNED; AND THAT IF THEY RECALLED ANYTHING ELSE CONCERNING THIS MATTER OR IF [REDACTED] WIFE NOTIFIED HIM OF ANY FURTHER INFORMATION REGARDING THIS MATTER THAT THEY WERE TO NOTIFY THE UNDERSIGNED IMMEDIATELY.

IT IS THE OPINION OF THE UNDERSIGNED THAT JENSEN IS POSSIBLY OVERREACTING TO THE SITUATION BUT FROM A SINCERE DESIRE THAT THIS INFORMATION BE REPORTED TO THE PROPER AUTHORITIES.

[REDACTED] SEEMS NERVOUS AND HIGHSTRUNG AND THE POSSIBILITY THAT HE IS FABRICATING THE ENTIRE STORY CANNOT BE RULED OUT.

THIS OFFICE CONTEMPLATES NO FURTHER ACTION AT THIS TIME. (u)
