DETAILS: On 12/4/78, [], PRC Desk, Department of State, advised Liaison Officer [], that he is a ham radio operator and that over the weekend of 11/25-26/78, he received a phone call from [], [], Connecticut, telephone number [], who is affiliated with the International Amateur Radio Union. According to [], he has heard tape recordings between Jonestown and Cuban amateur radio operators in which a caller from Jonestown mentioned "our people have finished their training and will return to the United States to go to work." [] also has information of a reported second camp, not further identified, in the jungle of Guyana. [] related that [] said he had received some "threats" following the killings in Guyana and was considering contacting the FBI.
