The following information is being provided for the benefit of the Bureau in the possible identification of as yet unknown victims in this matter: (u)

On 12/6/78, Mrs. [redacted], Kentucky, telephone [redacted], telephonically advised that she believes her daughter, [redacted] may have been a victim in the Jonestown suicides and murders occurring in Guyana. She could not cite a reason for her belief and stated that she last had contact with her daughter in July, 1976, when her daughter wrote her, the letter being postmarked at Hampton, Iowa. Mrs. [redacted] advised her daughter formerly taught school at Colorado Springs, Colorado. At the time of last contact with her daughter, Mrs. [redacted] stated that her daughter had been seeing a psychiatrist for some unknown reason. (u)
