At 2:00 p.m., 11/24/78, SA [ ] accepted an 8" by 11" sealed manila envelope stamped "Confidential" (reportedly containing a note found on the body of Reverend James Jones) from Mr. [ ], a civilian Air Force employee who is employed as a driver for the 436th Transportation Squadron, Dover Air Force Base (DAFB), Delaware. A receipt was given to [ ], acknowledging acceptance of this envelope by SA [ ] at the River Entrance, Pentagon, Washington, D. C. [ ] stated that he received the envelope at approximately 11:30 a.m., today, from Major [ ] the Information Officer at DAFB. (u)

[ ] stated that his instructions from Major [ ] were to deliver the envelope to the Pentagon, and upon arrival there to telephone Mr. [ ] at State Department, telephone number [ ], informing [ ] that he [ ] has a confidential package from Mr. [ ] at DAFB, and to ask [ ] what he [ ] is to do with the package. [ ] instructed [ ] to turn the package (envelope) over to FBI Special Agent [ ] at the River Entrance, Pentagon. [ ] also advised that he has no knowledge of what are the contents of the envelope.

The initials "LAC", together with the time and date of "2:00 p.m., 11/24/78" and the case code name of "RYMUR" were inscribed in the lower right hand corner of the envelope by SA [ ]. The envelope was subsequently turned over, at 2:35 p.m., 11/24/78, to SA [ ], Document Section, FBI Laboratory, J. Edgar Hoover Building, Washington, D. C., by SA [ ]. SA [ ] opened the envelope, in the presence of SA [ ], and it contained a smaller manila envelope within which was a white letter-size envelope. The white envelope contained a folded-note (deteriorated) enclosed in plastic. (u)

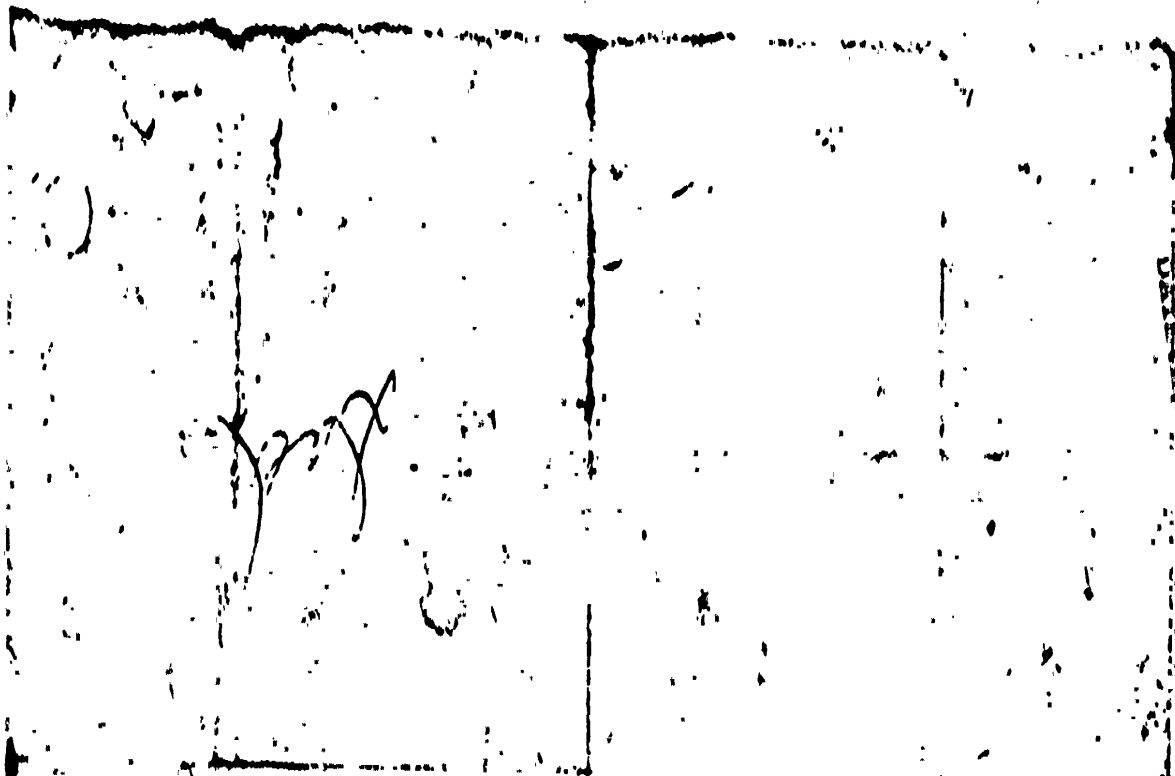
