Re Bureau R/S dated 11/29/78 to Buffalo with attached letter from Mrs. [redacted] of Syracuse, New York, dated 11/24/78. Communication re-routed to Albany from Buffalo (u)

Upon receipt of attached correspondence from Mrs. [redacted] dated 11/24/78, an indices check was conducted. This check disclosed that she is a chronic letter writer who has made irrational accusations and threatened suicide many times if she did not receive action on her demands (u)

[redacted] originally began writing letters to the FBI concerning her estate on 8/15/73, and in these letters, Mrs. [redacted] threatened suicide on 8/20/73. [redacted]'s son, [redacted], Syracuse, New York, was contacted by Buagents at which time [redacted] advised that he realized his mother had emotional problems and may be suffering from senility. [redacted] stated that he would immediately contact his mother regarding this matter; however, her letters have continued to be received over the years. (u)

Her attorney, [redacted], Syracuse, New York, was contacted and had advised that he was aware of her complaints and that on November 29, 1974, she would get an accounting of her estate in court. He also noted that the Merchants Bank was withdrawing as co-executor of the estate because of their inability to cope with Mrs. [redacted]'s irrational charges. He noted that Mrs. [redacted] is senile, and there is no basis for her allegations. (u)
