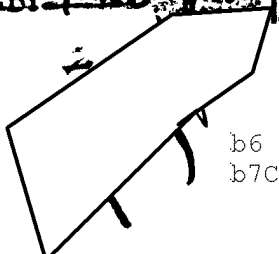

DURING INTERVIEW WITH MARK LANE AND HIS CLIENT, TERRI BUFORD, AT SAN JOSE, CALIFORNIA, TODAY, LANE ADVISED THAT HE DEVELOPED INFORMATION THAT GUNS WERE STORED IN THE BASEMENT OF CHARLES GARRY'S OFFICE, SAN FRANCISCO. LANE STATED HE TELEPHONICALLY ADVISED GARRY ON THE EVENING OF DECEMBER 5, 1978, TO THIS EFFECT. (u)

EVENING OF DECEMBER 5, 1978, ATTORNEY CHARLES GARRY PERSONALLY CONTACTED COP CHARLES GAIN, SFPD.
