[ ] ALSO RECALLED HE HEARD LENGTHLY BROADCAST CONCERNING CAESARIAN BIRTH OF TWINS, POSSIBLY IN LATE JUNE, 1978. HE ALSO STATED HE MONITORED PT STATION ON MANY OCCASIONS BUT COULD FURNISH NO INFORMATION REGARDING RYAN'S VISIT, WEAPONS, ETC. HE DID NOTE THAT PT SEEMED TO UTILIZE AN "IMPROVISED CODE" ON OCCASION. (u)

[ ] UNABLE TO FURNISH SPECIFIC NAMES OF PT RADIO OPERATORS BUT STATED TWO FEMALES DID MOST OF TALKING. HE BELIEVES DR. LAWRENCE SCHACT WAS ON THE AIR ON AT LEAST SEVERAL OCCASIONS. [ ] MADE NO TAPES OF ABOVE CONVERSATIONS. (u)

IN REGARD TO [ ], PILOT, BRITISH WEST INDIES AIRLINE (BWIA), AIRLINE PERSONNEL ADVISED [ ] HAS NOT ARRIVED MIAMI AND STOPS IN EFFECT. [ ] IS A "HAM" RADIO OPERATOR RESIDING IN THE BRITISH WEST INDIES. IT WAS SUGGESTED BY BWIA THAT [ ], COULD BEST BE INTERVIEWED AT NEW YORK INASMUCH AS FLIGHTS TO NEW YORK BY BWIA ARE "LAY-OVER" WHILE FLIGHTS TO MIAMI ARE "TURN-AROUND." [ ]'S FLIGHTS ARE THROUGH JFK INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.
