FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION

Date of transcription 11/27/78

[redacted], telephone number [redacted], advised that he is a ham radio operator and has monitored transmissions from Guyana, South America. These transmissions were made in both the legal and illegal ham radio bands. (u) b7C

[redacted] stated that he is aware of two calls belonging to individuals in Guyana, South America. These are: WB6-MNH/8RI belonging to PAULA J. ADAMS, 41 Dennis Street, Lamaha Gardens, Greater Georgetown, Guyana; United States address of 1664 Page Street, San Francisco, California. WB6-MID/8RI belonging to ALBERT TOUCHETTE, Port Kaituma, Northwest District, Guyana; United States address of 3747 Road B, Redwood Valley, California. (u) b7C

[redacted] continued that since November 18, 1978, he has recorded six transmissions that he believes are from Guyana, [redacted] is convinced that the female voice he recorded is identical to a female that had used the call signs from Guyana in the past. (u)

[redacted] stated that in the transmissions he recorded, the people appear to be using a code. [redacted] advised the recordings are being held by Chief of Police MATHEW HANEY, Cranford, New Jersey, Police Department. (u)

[redacted] further advised that in the recordings, it appears the female in Guyana is destroying something by taking it to a local dump and is very nervous about it. (u)
