[redacted] of the United States State Department (CACCS-BA) was interviewed at the Dover Air Force Base Mortuary at which time he provided the following information:

[redacted] advised that he received a handwritten note from WILLIAM G. COURTNEY, Chief of Air Force Mortuary Services the previous evening. The note which COURTNEY gave to [redacted] was obtained from the body of the Reverend JAMES JONES which had been examined in the Dover Air Force Base Mortuary on the evening of November 23, 1978. [redacted] advised that he had secured the note in a locker at the Dover Air Force Base Information Office after receiving it but that at 11:20 a.m. he gave the packaged note to a courier at the Dover Air Force Base to be delivered to the Headquarters of his Department in Washington, D. C.
