The doctor said that usually the body will expel these foreign particles. Mr. OLIVER, Mrs. OLIVER'S husband, had suffered a stroke in Georgetown, Guyana, when he learned of the killings at Jonesville, and is also a patient within the Naval Hospital according to Doctor  Mr. OLIVER is suffering from mild paralysis on the left side of his face, but according to Doctor  the prognosis for his recovery is also good.	•
