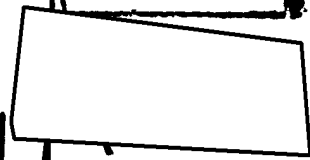

THE DETROIT NEWS. [] STATED HE HAD SOME INFORMATION OF A "DELICATE NATURE" CONCERNING THE JONESTOWN INCIDENT AND STATED IT WOULD BE WORTH [] EFFORT TO TRAVEL TO GUYANA AND DISCUSS THE SPECIFICS. [] INDICATED HE DID NOT WISH TO DISCUSS THE SPECIFICS OVER THE AIR. [] FURNISHED HIS TELEPHONE NUMBER TO [] (u)

ON NOVEMBER 26, 1978, [] CONTACTED [] [] VIA TELEPHONE, AND [] REPEATED THE SAME CONVERSATION THEY HAD HAD THE DAY PRIOR, AVOIDING SPECIFICS. [] ADDED THAT HE FELT THE AUTHORITIES IN GUYANA WERE MONITORING THE AIRWAYS AND TELEPHONE EQUIPMENT, THEREFORE, ANY DISCUSSIONS BETWEEN [] [] AND HIMSELF WOULD BE INTERCEPTED. [] IMPLIED THAT THE GUYANESE GOVERNMENT MAY NOT WANT THE COMPLETE TRUTH OF THE JONESTOWN INCIDENT TO BE KNOWN. (u)
