NOTE: On 12/8/78, 17 repatriating American survivors from the Jonestown, Guyana, massacre arrived at JFK International Airport and were interviewed by Bureau Agents. All 17 were served with a subpoena to appear before a Federal Grand Jury in San Francisco, California, beginning 12/10/78. Those persons represented by counsel before the grand jury requested a continuance date for their appearance inasmuch as they had not had time to discuss appearance with their lawyer. In this regard, defense lawyers requested and were granted an order by the court that the FBI produce the results of all interviews conducted with individuals scheduled to appear before the Federal Grand Jury. In granting the order the court advised the government that if the results of these interviews were not produced by 12/22/78 the court would quash the subpoenas. 71.
