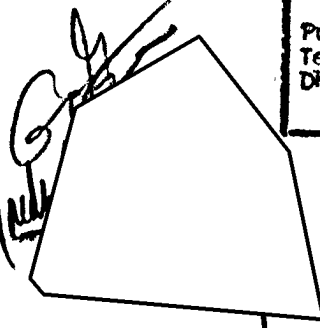

USA, SAN FRANCISCO, IN RECEIPT OF HAND DELIVERED LETTER DATED DECEMBER 12, 1978, FROM JOSEPH FREITAS, SAN FRANCISCO DA. THIS LETTER REQUESTS THAT IN VIEW OF POSSIBLE VIOLATIONS OF STATE LAW BY THE PT WITHIN HIS JURISDICTION THAT HIS OFFICE BE ADVISED: (1) THE PROGRESS OF THESE INVESTIGATIONS, (2) THAT A REPRESENTATIVE OF HIS OFFICE BE ALONG DURING THE INTERVIEW OF WITNESSES, AND (3) "WE ARE REQUESTING ACCESS TO ANY GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS IN WHICH THERE IS DEVELOPED EVIDENCE OF A VIOLATION OF STATE LAW."
