BLAKEY SHOWED THE CONSUL A TELEGRAM WHICH SHE HAD RECEIVED FROM HER SISTER INFORMING HER THAT A TICKET HAD BEEN PURCHASED IN HER NAME AND WEICH SPOKE OF A RENDEZVOUS IN CARACAS WITH HER SISTER AND BROTHER-IN-LAW ON HOLIDAY TO BE FOLLOWED BY A RETURN TO GEORGETOWN. MRS. BLAKEY EXPLAINED THAT THE TELEGRAM HAD BEEN A RUSE BY MEANS OF WHICH SHE HAD HOPED THAT THE PEOPLE'S TEMPLE ORGANIZATION WOULD CONSENT TO HER DEPARTURE ON THEIR ASSUMPTION THAT IT WAS TO BE ONLY A TEMPORARY ABSENCE FROM GUYANA FOR TOURIST TRAVEL WITE RELATIVES WITHIN THE AREA. WHEN SHE HAD SHOWN THE CAALE TO HER SUPERIORS WITHIN THE ORGANIZATION, THEY HAD TURNED DOWN HER REQUEST FOR LEAVE, ACCORDING TO MRS. BLAKEY. BLAKEY WAS UNABLE TO DEPART ON THE PAN AM FLIGHT ON MAY 12 DUE TO THE FACT THAT SHE HAD FAILED TO OBTAIN THE INCOME TAX CLEARANCE REQUIRED BY THE GUYANESE GOVERN-MENT OF ALL FOREIGN PERMANENT AND SEMI-PERMANENT RESIDENTS OF THE COUNTRY. THE CONSULAR OFFICER WHO HAD ACCOMPANIED HER TO THE AIRPORT AT HER REQUEST, RETURNED WITH HER TO GEORGETOWN WHERE SHE OBTAINED LODGING IN A LOCAL HOTEL. THE FOLLOWING MORNING MRS. SHE HAS MADE ARRANGEMENTS WITH HER SISTER FOR AN ONWARD FLIGHT TO CALIFORNIA FROM NEW YORK. THE MAY 13 FLIGET DEPARTED ON SCHEDULE WITH MRS. PLAKEY ON BOARD.
