SUBJ: INTERVIEW WITH MARK LANE

MARK LANE WAS CONTACTED IN HIS HOTEL BY FMBASSY OFFICIALS AND HE READILY AGREED TO GIVE A STATEMENT TO THEM REGARDING TER INCIDENT IN JONESTOWN. LANE BEGAN HIS NARRATION BY DESCRIPING THE EVENTS AFTER THE DEPARTURE OF CONGRESSMAN RYAN HIS PARTY. AND THOSE MEMBERS OF THE PROPLE'S TEMPLE WHO CHOSE TO GO WILP

1. LANE STATED THAT HE AND HIS COLLEAGUE. CHARLES GARY, MET FITH JIM JOVES AFTER CONGRESSMAN BYAN'S PARTY LEFT, AND ATTEMPTED TO PERSUADE EIM NOT TO TAKE DRASTIC MEASURES FOLLOWING THE DEPARTURE OF SOME OF HIS SECT'S MEMPERS. TEE MEETING WAS INTERRUPTED BY MARIE KATSARIS WHO SAID AFTER A WEISPERED CONSULTATION BETWEEN JONES AND IMPORTANT. KATSARIS -- ACCORDING TO LAKE -- JONES TOLD HIM AND GARY TO GO TO THE EAST CABIN BECAUSE THEY WERE IN DANGER. LANE SAID THE DON SLY. WHOM HE HAD HELPED TO DISARM IN THE FIRST ATTEMPT ON RYAN'S LIFE. WAS SENT TO GUARD TEEM. LANE SAID HE TEEN HEARD SEOUTS OF DEATH IS A DIGNITY AND LET'S GET CONFIDENTIAL

LANE STATED TEAT SOME CRAMES APPEARED TO BE SO EFAVY TEAT TWO MEN COULD NOT CARRY THEM SOR MORE TRAN A PROPERTIES AT A TIME. ALL THE PEOPLE HE COULD SEE. SAID LANE, WERE MOVING TOWARD A PAVILION ATOP A HILL.

2. LANE ALLEGES TEAT TWO MEN ROOWN TO FIM, NAMED PANCHO AND THOMPSON. STOPPED TO SPEAK TO HIM AND HIS COLLEAGUE. HI FPORTED ELAT ONE OF TEEM, PANCFO, APPEARED TO BE VERY HAPPY AND SAID "IT'S A FREAT THING TO DIE. TO DIE WITH DIGHTY." THAT HE DISPUTED THIS IDEA SOMEWHAT WITH PANCHO. BUT THAT EVENTUALLY DECIDED TO FLEE TEE AREA. HE ASKED FOR, AND RECEIVED. DIRECTIONS TO THE ROAD TO PORT KATUMA PROM PANCHES LANE SAID TEAT THOMPSON AT TELE POINT SHOUTED TEAT "JIM

IS THE GREATEST MAN IN THE WORLD" AS THE TWO ATTORNEYS PAN FROM JONESTOWN.

J. AS THEY WERE LEAVING. LANE SAID. HE HEARD JIM JONES CHANK WHAT SOUNDED LIKE "MOTHER, MOTHER, MOTHER" OVER THE PA SYSTEM. WEEN ASKED IF JIM JONES PAD TO BE IN THE PAVILION TO USE THE PA SYSTEM. LANF REPLIED IN THE NEGATIVE, BUT INDICATED THAT HE FELT THAT JONES WAS IN THE PAVILION. LANE THEM ALLEGES THAT HE HEARD PO TO 90 SHOTS.

4. LANE TEEN PACKTRACKED IN TIME, AND SAID TEAT JONES FA SAID PRIOR TO THE INTERRUPTION BY MARIE KATSARIS, THAT THE FEOPLE WHO HAD LEFT HIS ORGANIZATION FOR CONGRESSMAN RYAN RAD DONE IT ONLY BECAUSE THEY PLANNED TO KILL RYAN. AND HE COULD PREDICT THAT THEY WOULD. LANE ALLEGES THAT HE DID NOT BELIEVE THE STORY OR THE "PROPHECY" AT THE TIME. HE PUR HER STATED THAT HE DID NOT LEARN OF THE AIRPORT ATTACK UNTIL HE CONFIDENTIAL

WAS BACK IN GEORGETOWN.

5. LANE CONTINUED WITH HIS NARRATIVE OF HIS ESCAPE. PE SAID THAT HE AND JARY HAD WALKED ALONG THE ROAD, KEEPING WELL TO THE SIDE IN ORDER TO AVOID ANYONE BLSE. JUST AS IT WAS CETTING DARK. HE SAID THAT HE SPIED TWO MEN (BUT SAID THAT GARY BELIEVED IT WAS A GROUP OF TEREE) ON THE ROAD CARRYING WHAT APPEARED TO REPORTLOCKERS. HE AND GARY SOUGHT SHELTER IN THE BUSH ALONG THE ROAD TO AVOID DETECTION AND REMAINED IN THE JUNGLE UNTIL HABLY MORNING. LANE INDICATED THAT THE STEKING OF COVER HAD BEEN A TECTICAL MISTAKE BECAUSE IT TOOK THEM SEVERAL HOURS TO REGAIN THE ROAD. HE SAID THAT THE BUSH IS WERY THICK AND THE SENSE OF DIRECTION THROWN WAY OFF. AT ABOUT 7:45 ACCORDING TO LANE, HE ERARD ABOUT 15-25 ROUNDS OF AUTOMATIC PIRE, AND THEY PLED THE ARLA AS FAST AS POSSIBLE.

G. IN REPLY TO A DIJECT QUESTION. LANE SAID THAT PE RAD ORIGINALLY THOUGHT THAT JONES HAD DIZD ALONG WITE HIS SECT'S MEMBERS, BUT THAT HE BEGAN HAVING SECOND THOUGHTS AFTER SEEING THE LOCKERS BEING CARRIED THROUGH THE JUNGLE. HE KNOW FOR A FACT, HE SAID, THAT JONES HAD TWO OR THREE MILLION LLARS IN HIS CABIN. HE HAD NEVER SEEN IT, BUT ALLEGED THAT HE WAS SURE IT HAS THERE, AND EVEN KNEW WHO HAD BROUGHT IT INTO GUYANA AND HOW. HE DECLINED TO NAME THE SOURCE OF HIS INFORMATION, BUT SAID THAT HE WOULD DISCUSS IT WITH HIM AND PERHAPS IN EXCHANGE FOR IMMUNITY, THE INDIVIDUAL MIGHT EXPLAIN THE WEYS AND WHEREFORES.

7. AGAIN IN REPLY TO A DIRECT QUESTION. HE STATED THAT THE MEN CARRYING THE LOCKERS WERE HEADED IN THE GENERAL DIRECTION OF THE PLACE WHERE THE PEOPLE'S TEMPLE BOAT WAS MOORED, BUT ADMITTED THAT IT WAS ALSO IN THE GENERAL DIRECTION OF THE ROUTE HE WAS TAKING TO REACE PORT KAITUMA. HE REPEATEDLY DISCLAIMED ANY KNOWLEDGE OF A CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR JONES PECAPE. IN THE EVENT IT BECAMY NECESSARY. HE SAID THAT JONES TALKED OF SENDING A DELEGATION TO THE SOVIET UNION AND

PERSAPS OF MOVING THE COMMUNE THEFE. BUT FAD WEVER MENTIONED ANY PLANS INVOLVING HIS OWN ESCAPE.

3. WHEN ASKED IF HE HAD DETECTED ANY CHANGE IN THE ATMOSPHEAE IN JONESTOWN DURING THE CONGRESSMAN'S VISIT. HE SAID NOT IN THE COMMUNITY IN GENERAL. HE ALLEGED. HOWEVER, THAT HE SENSED A CHANGE IN JIM JONES, THAT HE HAD SIEMED VIRY CALM AND THAT HE (LANE) FELT THAT SOMETHING WAS GOING TO HAPPEN.
