NEVILLE ANNIBOURNE, THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION OFFICIAL
WHO ACCOMPANIED THE CONGRESSIONAL PARTY TO JONESTOWN
ON NOV 17, GAVE HIS ACCOUNT OF EVENTS AT PORT KAITUMA ON
NOV 18. ANNIBOURNE THEN WAS CROSS-EXAMINED BY
SENIOR DEFENSE COUNSEL REX MCKAY. DETECTIVE ASSISTANCE
SUPERINTENDENT EUSTACE KENDALL, THE GUYANA POLICE FIREARMS
EXPERT, TESTIFIED CONCERNING A .38 CALIBRE REVOLVER USED
IN THE SHOOTING AND EXPENDED AMMUNITION FOUND AT THE
AIRSTRIIP. JAI NARAIN SINGH, COUNSEL PRO THE DEFENSE,
CROSS-EXAMINED KENDALL. A GUYANA DEFENCE FORCE PILOT WHO
TRANSPORTED THE BODIES ON NOV 19 FROM PORT KAITUMA TO
GEORGETOWN THEN TESTIFIED BRIEFLY. DEFENSE DECLINED
CROSS-EXAMINATION.
