[REDACTED] WAS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED AS HAVING MADE TAPES OF SHORT WAVE BROADCASTS BETWEEN PEOPLE'S TEMPLE IN GUYANA AND THEIR SAN FRANCISCO TEMPLE. CONSUL JOHN ADAMS ADVISED THAT [REDACTED] HAD ALREADY FURNISHED THESE TAPES TO UNITED STATES AUTHORITIES, HOWEVER, HAD NOT BEEN INTERVIEWED TO DATE. (u)

[REDACTED] INFORMED ADAMS HE WOULD BE STAYING AT THE HOWARD JOHNSON'S NEAR JOHN F. KENNEDY AND WOULD BE RETURNING TO TRINIDAD ON DECEMBER 24, 1978, EARLY IN THE DAY. ADAMS FURNISHED [REDACTED] HOME TELEPHONE NUMBER IN PORT OF SPAIN AS FOLLOWS: [REDACTED] (u)
