[redacted] advised that she did not know of the existence of any security force. She stated that she was not familiar with the term "The Angels." She advised that she has no knowledge of any members of the Jonestown Basketball Team, since she was never in Jonestown. (u)

[redacted] advised that she had no knowledge of any bribery or influence peddling by members of the Peoples Temple. (u)

[redacted] advised that she had no knowledge of any plans or discussions with regard to the assassination of Congressman RYAN. (u)

[redacted] advised that she had no knowledge of the existence of suicide drills or the existence of any assassination squad. (u)

[redacted] advised that she first became familiar with JIM JONES at the age of two years old when she lived in Indianapolis, Indiana. She advised that in 1967 when she was 13 years old, she moved to San Francisco to live with a woman named [redacted]. She stated that [redacted] was affiliated with the Peoples Temple. She stated that she subsequently lived in a Peoples Temple dormitory while attending Santa Rosa Community College. She stated that in November, 1972, she left the Peoples Temple, however, was persuaded by her ex-husband to return to the Peoples Temple in January, 1973. She stated that upon her return she was considered by other members to be unfaithful and untrustworthy. She stated that the Peoples Temple had moved toward heavy Catharism and constant interrogation of members. [redacted] advised that she left the Peoples Temple in August, 1973, and after being telephonically harassed by members she left California in April, 1974, and has had no contact with any members of the Peoples Temple.
