ROBERT PECKHAM, NDC, ORDERED THAT FD-302'S REGARDING INTERVIEWS
OF CERTAIN PEOPLE'S TEMPLE (PT) MEMBERS BE TURNED OVER TO
WITNESS ATTORNEYS BY DECEMBER 22, 1978. (u)

ON THIS DATE, AUSA RICHARD BREWSTER, CHIEF CRIMINAL
DIVISION, EDNY, ADVISED THAT THIS IS PREPOSTOROUS, AND WITNESS
ATTORNEYS NOT ENTITLED TO INTERVIEWS. AUSA BREWSTER ADVISED
THAT NONE OF THE INDIVIDUALS INTERVIEWED HAVE BEEN FORMALLY
CHARGED AND HAVE BEEN SUBPOENAED AS WITNESSES. AUSA BREWSTER
