1. PRELIMINARY INQUIRY INTO THE DEATHS OF CONGRESSMAN RYAN

THE CONGRESSIONAL PARTY HAD LEFT JONESTOWN, JONES SAID THAT
"RYAN WOULD BE KILLED." MCKAY OBJECTED THAT THIS STATEMENT WAS
HEARSAY AND THUS INADMISSIBLE. PROSECUTING COUNSEL NANDRAM
KISSOON CONTENDED THAT THE STATEMENT WAS ADMISSIBLE AS PART
OF THE EVIDENCE WHICH WOULD SHOW THAT A CONSPIRACY EXISTED
BETWEEN JIM JONES, LAYTON AND OTHERS TO KILL RYAN. MAGISTRATE
CHINTA AGREED WITH MCKAY THAT THE STATEMENT WAS INADMISSIBLE
BECAUSE THERE HAD BEEN NO EVIDENCE BROUGHT FORTH TO DATE TO
SHOW THAT A CONSPIRACY HAD BEEN LAID. RHODES SUBSEQUENTLY
FINISHED HIS TESTIMONY AFTER CROSS-EXAMINATION AND RE-
EXAMINATION WERE CONCLUDED.
