

PRODUCED A "CHRONICLE SPECIAL" DEVOTED EXCLUSIVELY TO THE JONESTOWN INCIDENT. ON THE BACK PAGE OF THE SPECIAL WAS AN EXTRACT FROM ONE OF THE DOCUMENTS TITLED "LINK WITH THE RUSSIANS". ANOTHER ARTICLE TITLED "PEOPLE'S TEMPLE PLANNED MASS EXODUS TO U.S.S.R." APPEARED ON PAGES 16 AND 17 OF THE SPECIAL. CUBA WAS ALSO MENTIONED IN SEVERAL OF THE ARTICLES BUT IN A LESS DAMAGING MANNER.
