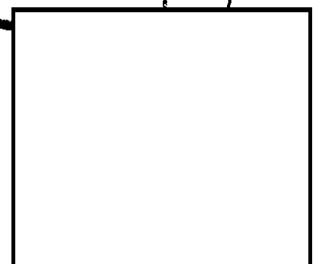

1. PRELIMINARY INQUIRY INTO THE DEATHS OF CONGRESSMAN RYAN AND FOUR OTHER AMERICANS WAS CONTINUED ON DEC 27. BEFORE TESTIMONY BEGAN, SENIOR DEFENSE COUNSEL REX MCKAY COMPLAINED TO THE COURT THAT LOCAL NEWSPAPERS NEEDED TO EXERCISE GREATER CAUTION AND DISCRETION WHEN PUBLISHING ARTICLES WRITTEN OVERSEAS ON PEOPLES TEMPLE. SOME OF THE ARTICLES THAT HAD BEEN REPRINTED IN THE GUYANESE PAPERS, HE CLAIMED, HAD "INFLAMED" LOCAL GUYANESE. THIS COULD BE PREJUDICIAL TO HIS CLIENT, BECAUSE THE JURORS WHO WILL BE SELECTED TO HEAR THE CASE IN THE HIGH COURT WILL HAVE READ THE LOCAL NEWSPAPERS CONTAINING THESE ARTICLES.

ALSO TESTIFIED. ALL THREE WERE CROSS-EXAMINED BY MCKAY.
A POLICEMAN, WHO HAD EARLIER TESTIFIED ON ANOTHER MATTER,
SWORE THAT HE ACCOMPANIED THE BODIES OF THE SLAIN AMERICANS
FROM OGLE AIRPORT, JUST OUTSIDE GEORGETOWN, TO THE GEORGETOWN
HOSPITAL MORTUARY ON NOV 19. CROSS-EXAMINATION WAS DECLINED
BY THE DEFENSE.

3. INQUIRY IS SCHEDULED TO RESUME ON DEC 29. ONLY
WITNESSES LEFT TO TESTIFY FOR THE PROSECUTION ARE SEVERAL
RESIDENTS FROM PORT KAITUMA WHO RENDERED ASSISTANCE TO
AMERICANS AFTER THE SHOOTING.
