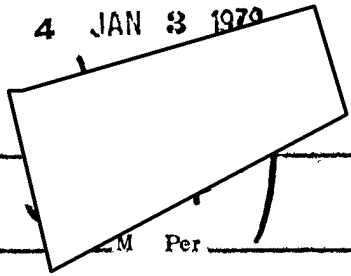

[redacted] East Brunswick, New Jersey, home telephone [redacted] was interviewed for any information he could provide of the People's Temple Agricultural Mission in Guyana, South America. (u)

[redacted] advised that he was a hand radio operator and that on five occasions during, 1978, three in January, 1978, one in April, and one in October, he had talked to an individual operating a "ham" radio in Georgetown, and Jonestown, South America. (u)

[redacted] advised that the person on the radio always seemed to be in good spirits and seemed to be pleased with the operation in Jonestown, South America. He stated that the radio operator always was cheerful and indicated that the people in South America, were friendly to the United States. (u)

[redacted] stated that he had received two postcards from the people in Jonestown, South America. He advised that one card was received on August 4, 1978, and the card indicated that the area was a beautiful country, and that the people were friendly and that the People's Temple was doing a fine job. This card was signed by AL and SARAH. (u)

[redacted] further stated that on October 1, 1978, he received a card from LEE and AL thanking him for the encouragement and also mentioning that they had a free medical clinic. [redacted] could furnish no further information concerning the People's Temple Agricultural Mission, in Jonestown, South America. (u)
